19	1. Virginia Herold ("Complainant") brings this Accusation solely in her official capacity	
20	as the Executive Officer of the Board of Pharmacy ("Board"), Department of Consumer Affairs.	
21	2. On or about March 27, 2012, the Board issued Pharmacy Technician Registration	
22	Number TCH 120740 to Brissa Leal ("Respondent). The pharmacy technician registration	
23	expired on August 31, 2015.	
24	JURISDICTION/STATUTORY PROVISIONS	
25	3. This Accusation is brought before the Board under the authority of the following	
26	laws. All section references are to the Business and Professions Code unless otherwise indicated.	
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chapter. A plea or verdict of guilty or a conviction following a plea of nolo contendere is deemed to be a conviction within the meaning of this provision. The board may take action when the time for appeal has elapsed, or the judgment of conviction has been affirmed on appeal or when an order granting probation is made suspending the imposition of sentence, irrespective of a subsequent order under Section 1203.4 of the Penal Code allowing the person to withdraw his or her plea of guilty and to enter a plea of not guilty, or setting aside the verdict of guilty, or dismissing the accusation, information, or indictment . . .

COST RECOVERY

7. Section 125.3 provides, in pertinent part, that a Board may request the administrative law judge to direct a licentiate found to have committed a violation or violations of the licensing act to pay a sum not to exceed the reasonable costs of the investigation and enforcement of the case.

DRUG CLASSIFICATIONS

8. "Methamphetamine" is a Schedule II controlled substance as designated by Health and Safety Code section 11055, subdivision (d)(2).

FIRST CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

(Criminal Conviction)

9. Respondent is subject to disciplinary action for unprofessional conduct pursuant to section 4301, subdivision (I), in that on or about October 9, 2015, in the criminal proceeding entitled *People vs. Brissa Leal* (Tulare County Super. Ct., Case No. VCM314918), Respondent pled guilty to violating Health and Safety Code section 11377, subdivision (a) (unlawful possession of a controlled substance), a misdemeanor. The circumstances of the crime are as follows. On or about January 5, 2015, a Visalia Police Department Officer conducted an enforcement stop on Respondent's vehicle. The officer made contact with Respondent and asked her if she had anything illegal inside of her vehicle. Respondent stated "no", then consented to a search of her vehicle. The officer searched the vehicle and found two plastic baggies with a rock like substance inside of each baggie. The officer determined later that the baggies contained methamphetamine.

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SECOND CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

(Violations of State Laws Regulating Controlled Substances)

10. Respondent is subject to disciplinary action for unprofessional conduct pursuant to section 4301, subdivision (j), in that on or about January 5, 2015, Respondent possessed the controlled substance methamphetamine in violation of Health and Safety Code section 11377, subdivision (a), as set forth in paragraph 9 above.

PRAYER

WHEREFORE, Complainant requests that a hearing be held on the matters herein alleged, and that following the hearing, the Board of Pharmacy issue a decision:

- 1. Revoking or suspending Pharmacy Technician Registration Number TCH 120740, issued to Brissa Leal;
- 2. Ordering Brissa Leal to pay the Board of Pharmacy the reasonable costs of the investigation and enforcement of this case, pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 125.3; and
 - 3. Taking such other and further action as deemed necessary and proper.
