19 **STIPULATED SETTLEMENT AND**
20 **DISCIPLINARY ORDER**

21 In the interest of a prompt and speedy settlement of this matter, consistent with the public
22 interest and the responsibility of the Board of Pharmacy of the Department of Consumer Affairs,
23 the parties hereby agree to the following Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order which will
24 be submitted to the Board for approval and adoption as the final disposition of the Accusation.

25 **PARTIES**

26 1. Anne Sodergren (“Complainant”) is the Interim Executive Officer of the Board of
27 Pharmacy (the “Board”). She brought this action solely in her official capacity and is represented
28 in this matter by Xavier Becerra, Attorney General of the State of California, by Stephen D.
Svetich, Deputy Attorney General.

1 **CULPABILITY**

2 9. Respondent understands and agrees that the charges and allegations in Accusation
3 No. 6320, if proven at a hearing, constitute cause for imposing discipline upon her Pharmacist
4 License.

5 10. For the purpose of resolving the Accusation without the expense and uncertainty of
6 further proceedings, Respondent agrees that, at a hearing, Complainant could establish a factual
7 basis for the charges in the Accusation, and that Respondent hereby gives up her right to contest
8 those charges.

9 11. Respondent agrees that her Pharmacist License is subject to discipline and she agrees
10 to be bound by the Board's probationary terms as set forth in the Disciplinary Order below.

11 **CONTINGENCY**

12 12. This stipulation shall be subject to approval by the Board of Pharmacy. Respondent
13 understands and agrees that counsel for Complainant and the staff of the Board of Pharmacy may
14 communicate directly with the Board regarding this stipulation and settlement, without notice to
15 or participation by Respondent or her counsel. By signing the stipulation, Respondent
16 understands and agrees that she may not withdraw her agreement or seek to rescind the stipulation
17 prior to the time the Board considers and acts upon it. If the Board fails to adopt this stipulation
18 as its Decision and Order, the Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order shall be of no force or
19 effect, except for this paragraph, it shall be inadmissible in any legal action between the parties,
20 and the Board shall not be disqualified from further action by having considered this matter.

21 13. The parties understand and agree that Portable Document Format (“PDF”) and
22 facsimile copies of this Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order, including PDF and
23 facsimile signatures thereto, shall have the same force and effect as the originals.

24 14. This Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order is intended by the parties to be an
25 integrated writing representing the complete, final, and exclusive embodiment of their agreement.
26 It supersedes any and all prior or contemporaneous agreements, understandings, discussions,
27 negotiations, and commitments (written or oral). This Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary
28

1 Order may not be altered, amended, modified, supplemented, or otherwise changed except by a
2 writing executed by an authorized representative of each of the parties.

3 15. In consideration of the foregoing admissions and stipulations, the parties agree that
4 the Board may, without further notice or formal proceeding, issue and enter the following
5 Disciplinary Order:

7 **DISCIPLINARY ORDER**

8 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pharmacist License No. RPH 66729 issued to Respondent
9 Hebatullah Ahmed Taha is revoked. However, the revocation is stayed and Respondent is placed
10 on probation for three (3) years on the following terms and conditions.

11 1. **Obey All Laws**

12 Respondent shall obey all state and federal laws and regulations.

13 Respondent shall report any of the following occurrences to the board, in writing, within
14 seventy- two (72) hours of such occurrence:

- 15 • an arrest or issuance of a criminal complaint for violation of any provision of the
16 Pharmacy Law, state and federal food and drug laws, or state and federal controlled
17 substances laws
- 18 • a plea of guilty, or nolo contendere, no contest, or similar, in any state or federal
19 criminal proceeding to any criminal complaint, information or indictment
- 20 • a conviction of any crime
- 21 • the filing of a disciplinary pleading, issuance of a citation, or initiation of another
22 administrative action filed by any state or federal agency which involves
23 respondent's license or which is related to the practice of pharmacy or the
24 manufacturing, obtaining, handling, distributing, billing, or charging for any drug,
25 device or controlled substance.

26 Failure to timely report such occurrence shall be considered a violation of probation.

27 2. **Report to the Board**

28 Respondent shall report to the board quarterly, on a schedule as directed by the board or its

1 designee. The report shall be made either in person or in writing, as directed. Among other
2 requirements, respondent shall state in each report under penalty of perjury whether there has
3 been compliance with all the terms and conditions of probation.

4 Failure to submit timely reports in a form as directed shall be considered a violation of
5 probation. Any period(s) of delinquency in submission of reports as directed may be added to the
6 total period of probation. Moreover, if the final probation report is not made as directed,
7 probation shall be automatically extended until such time as the final report is made and accepted
8 by the board.

9 **3. Interview with the Board**

10 Upon receipt of reasonable prior notice, respondent shall appear in person for interviews
11 with the board or its designee, at such intervals and locations as are determined by the board or its
12 designee. Failure to appear for any scheduled interview without prior notification to board staff,
13 or failure to appear for two (2) or more scheduled interviews with the board or its designee during
14 the period of probation, shall be considered a violation of probation.

15 **4. Cooperate with Board Staff**

16 Respondent shall timely cooperate with the board's inspection program and with the board's
17 monitoring and investigation of respondent's compliance with the terms and conditions of her
18 probation, including but not limited to: timely responses to requests for information by board
19 staff; timely compliance with directives from board staff regarding requirements of any term or
20 condition of probation; and timely completion of documentation pertaining to a term or condition
21 of probation. Failure to timely cooperate shall be considered a violation of probation.

22 **5. Continuing Education**

23 Respondent shall provide evidence of efforts to maintain skill and knowledge as a
24 pharmacist as directed by the board or its designee.

25 **6. Reporting of Employment and Notice to Employers**

26 During the period of probation, respondent shall notify all present and prospective
27 employers of the decision in case number 6320 and the terms, conditions and restrictions imposed
28 on respondent by the decision, as follows:

1 Within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this decision, and within ten (10) days of
2 undertaking any new employment, respondent shall report to the board in writing the name,
3 physical address, and mailing address of each of her employer(s), and the name(s) and telephone
4 number(s) of all of her direct supervisor(s), as well as any pharmacist(s)-in-charge, designated
5 representative(s)-in-charge, responsible manager, or other compliance supervisor(s) and the work
6 schedule, if known. Respondent shall also include the reason(s) for leaving the prior
7 employment. Respondent shall sign and return to the board a written consent authorizing the
8 board or its designee to communicate with all of respondent's employer(s) and supervisor(s), and
9 authorizing those employer(s) or supervisor(s) to communicate with the board or its designee,
10 concerning respondent's work status, performance, and monitoring. Failure to comply with the
11 requirements or deadlines of this condition shall be considered a violation of probation.

12 Within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this decision, and within fifteen (15) days of
13 respondent undertaking any new employment, respondent shall cause (a) her direct supervisor, (b)
14 her pharmacist-in-charge, designated representative-in-charge, responsible manager, or other
15 compliance supervisor, and (c) the owner or owner representative of her employer, to report to the
16 board in writing acknowledging that the listed individual(s) has/have read the decision in case
17 number 6320, and terms and conditions imposed thereby. If one person serves in more than one
18 role described in (a), (b), or (c), the acknowledgment shall so state. It shall be the respondent's
19 responsibility to ensure that these acknowledgment(s) are timely submitted to the board. In the
20 event of a change in the person(s) serving the role(s) described in (a), (b), or (c) during the term
21 of probation, respondent shall cause the person(s) taking over the role(s) to report to the board in
22 writing within fifteen (15) days of the change acknowledging that he or she has read the decision
23 in case number 6320, and the terms and conditions imposed thereby.

24 If respondent works for or is employed by or through an employment service, respondent
25 must notify the person(s) described in (a), (b), and (c) above at every entity licensed by the board
26 of the decision in case number 6320, and the terms and conditions imposed thereby in advance of
27 respondent commencing work at such licensed entity. A record of this notification must be
28 provided to the board upon request.

1 Furthermore, within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this decision, and within fifteen
2 (15) days of respondent undertaking any new employment by or through an employment service,
3 respondent shall cause the person(s) described in (a), (b), and (c) above at the employment service
4 to report to the board in writing acknowledging that she has read the decision in case number, and
5 the terms and conditions imposed thereby. It shall be respondent's responsibility to ensure that
6 these acknowledgment(s) are timely submitted to the board.

7 Failure to timely notify present or prospective employer(s) or failure to cause the identified
8 person(s) with that/those employer(s) to submit timely written acknowledgments to the board
9 shall be considered a violation of probation.

10 "Employment" within the meaning of this provision includes any full-time, part-time,
11 temporary, relief, or employment/management service position as a Pharmacist, or any position
12 for which a Pharmacist is a requirement or criterion for employment, whether the respondent is an
13 employee, independent contractor or volunteer.

14 **7. Notification of Change(s) in Name, Address(es), or Phone Number(s)**

15 Respondent shall further notify the board in writing within ten (10) days of any change in
16 name, residence address, mailing address, e-mail address or phone number.

17 Failure to timely notify the board of any change in employer, name, address, or phone
18 number shall be considered a violation of probation.

19 **8. Restrictions on Supervision and Oversight of Licensed Facilities**

20 During the period of probation, Respondent shall not supervise any intern pharmacist or serve as a
21 consultant to any entity licensed by the board. Respondent may be a pharmacist-in-charge, designated
22 representative-in-charge, responsible manager or other compliance supervisor of any single entity licensed
23 by the board, but only if respondent or that entity retains, at her expense, an independent consultant who
24 shall be responsible for reviewing the operations of the entity on a monthly basis for compliance by
25 Respondent and the entity with state and federal laws and regulations governing the practice of the entity,
26 and compliance by Respondent with the obligations of her supervisory position. Respondent may serve in
27 such a position at only one entity licensed by the board, only upon approval by the board or its designee.
28 Any such approval shall be site specific. The consultant shall be a pharmacist licensed by and not on

1 probation with the board, who has been approved by the board or its designee to serve in this position.
2 Respondent shall submit the name of the proposed consultant to the board or its designee for approval
3 within thirty (30) days of the effective date of the decision or prior to assumption of duties allowed in this
4 term. Assumption of any unauthorized supervision responsibilities shall be considered a violation of
5 probation. In addition, failure to timely seek approval for, timely retain, or ensure timely reporting by the
6 consultant shall be considered a violation of probation. At this time, Respondent is only approved to work
7 as the pharmacist-in-charge at CVS Pharmacy No. 10310, located at 1795 E. Lugonia Avenue, Redlands,
8 California 92374.

9 **9. Reimbursement of Board Costs**

10 As a condition precedent to successful completion of probation, respondent shall pay to the
11 board its costs of investigation and prosecution in the amount of \$11,510.75. Respondent shall be
12 permitted to pay these costs in a payment plan approved by the board or its designee, so long as
13 full payment is completed no later than three (3) months prior to the end date of probation.

14 **10. Probation Monitoring Costs**

15 Respondent shall pay any costs associated with probation monitoring as determined by the
16 board each and every year of probation. Such costs shall be payable to the board on a schedule as
17 directed by the board or its designee. Failure to pay such costs by the deadline(s) as directed shall
18 be considered a violation of probation.

19 **11. Status of License**

20 Respondent shall, at all times while on probation, maintain an active, current Pharmacist
21 License with the board, including any period during which suspension or probation is tolled.
22 Failure to maintain an active, current Pharmacist License shall be considered a violation of
23 probation.

24 If respondent's Pharmacist License expires or is cancelled by operation of law or otherwise
25 at any time during the period of probation, including any extensions thereof due to tolling or
26 otherwise, upon renewal or reapplication respondent's license shall be subject to all terms and
27 conditions of this probation not previously satisfied.

28 ///

1 **12. License Surrender While on Probation/Suspension**

2 Following the effective date of this decision, should respondent cease practice due to
3 retirement or health, or be otherwise unable to satisfy the terms and conditions of probation,
4 respondent may relinquish her license, including any indicia of licensure issued by the board,
5 along with a request to surrender the license. The board or its designee shall have the discretion
6 whether to accept the surrender or take any other action it deems appropriate and reasonable.
7 Upon formal acceptance of the surrender of the license, respondent will no longer be subject to
8 the terms and conditions of probation. This surrender constitutes a record of discipline and shall
9 become a part of the respondent’s license history with the board.

10 Upon acceptance of the surrender, respondent shall relinquish her pocket and/or wall
11 license, including any indicia of licensure not previously provided to the board within ten (10)
12 days of notification by the board that the surrender is accepted if not already provided.
13 Respondent may not reapply for any license from the board for three (3) years from the effective
14 date of the surrender. Respondent shall meet all requirements applicable to the license sought as
15 of the date the application for that license is submitted to the board, including any outstanding
16 costs.

17 **13. Practice Requirement – Extension of Probation**

18 Except during periods of suspension, respondent shall, at all times while on probation, be
19 employed as a Pharmacist in California for a minimum of 80 (eighty) hours per calendar month.
20 Any month during which this minimum is not met shall extend the period of probation by one
21 month. During any such period of insufficient employment, respondent must nonetheless comply
22 with all terms and conditions of probation, unless respondent receives a waiver in writing from
23 the board or its designee.

24 If respondent does not practice as a Pharmacist in California for the minimum number of
25 hours in any calendar month, for any reason (including vacation), respondent shall notify the
26 board in writing within ten (10) days of the conclusion of that calendar month. This notification
27 shall include at least: the date(s), location(s), and hours of last practice; the reason(s) for the
28 interruption or reduction in practice; and the anticipated date(s) on which respondent will resume

1 practice at the required level. Respondent shall further notify the board in writing within ten (10)
2 days following the next calendar month during which respondent practices as a Pharmacist in
3 California for the minimum of hours. Any failure to timely provide such notification(s) shall be
4 considered a violation of probation.

5 It is a violation of probation for respondent's probation to be extended pursuant to the
6 provisions of this condition for a total period, counting consecutive and non-consecutive months,
7 exceeding thirty-six (36) months. The board or its designee may post a notice of the extended
8 probation period on its website.

9 **14. Violation of Probation**

10 If respondent has not complied with any term or condition of probation, the board shall
11 have continuing jurisdiction over respondent, and the board shall provide notice to respondent
12 that probation shall automatically be extended, until all terms and conditions have been satisfied
13 or the board has taken other action as deemed appropriate to treat the failure to comply as a
14 violation of probation, to terminate probation, and to impose the penalty that was stayed. The
15 board or its designee may post a notice of the extended probation period on its website.

16 If respondent violates probation in any respect, the board, after giving respondent notice
17 and an opportunity to be heard, may revoke probation and carry out the disciplinary order that
18 was stayed. If a petition to revoke probation or an accusation is filed against respondent during
19 probation, or the preparation of an accusation or petition to revoke probation is requested from
20 the Office of the Attorney General, the board shall have continuing jurisdiction and the period of
21 probation shall be automatically extended until the petition to revoke probation or accusation is
22 heard and decided, and the charges and allegations in Accusation No. 6320 shall be deemed true
23 and correct.

24 **15. Completion of Probation**

25 Upon written notice by the board or its designee indicating successful completion of
26 probation, respondent's license will be fully restored.

1 **16. Remedial Education**

2 Within sixty (60) days of the effective date of this decision, respondent shall submit to the
3 board or its designee, for prior approval, an appropriate program of remedial education related to
4 administration of a pharmacy, the role of a pharmacist-in-charge, and corresponding
5 responsibility. The program of remedial education shall consist of at least 10 hours each year of
6 probation, which shall be completed at respondent's own expense. At least 50% of the remedial
7 education courses shall be in-person or live online courses. All remedial education shall be in
8 addition to, and shall not be credited toward, continuing education (CE) courses used for license
9 renewal purposes for pharmacists.

10 Failure to timely submit for approval or complete the approved remedial education shall be
11 considered a violation of probation. The period of probation will be automatically extended until
12 such remedial education is successfully completed and written proof, in a form acceptable to the
13 board, is provided to the board or its designee.

14 Following the completion of each course, the board or its designee may require the
15 respondent, at her own expense, to take an approved examination to test the respondent's
16 knowledge of the course. If the respondent does not achieve a passing score on the examination
17 that course shall not count towards satisfaction of this term. Respondent shall take another course
18 approved by the board in the same subject area.

19 **17. Ethics Course**

20 Within sixty (60) calendar days of the effective date of this decision, respondent shall enroll
21 in a course in ethics, at respondent's expense, approved in advance by the board or its designee
22 that complies with Title 16 California Code of Regulations section 1773.5. Respondent shall
23 provide proof of enrollment upon request. Within five (5) days of completion, respondent shall
24 submit a copy of the certificate of completion to the board or its designee. Failure to timely enroll
25 in an approved ethics course, to initiate the course during the first year of probation, to
26 successfully complete it before the end of the second year of probation, or to timely submit proof
27 of completion to the board or its designee, shall be considered a violation of probation.

18. No Ownership or Management of Licensed Premises

Respondent shall not own, have any legal or beneficial interest in, nor serve as a manager, administrator, member, officer, director, trustee, associate, or partner of any business, firm, partnership, or corporation currently or hereinafter licensed by the board. Respondent shall sell or transfer any legal or beneficial interest in any entity licensed by the board within ninety (90) days following the effective date of this decision and shall immediately thereafter provide written proof thereof to the board. Failure to timely divest any legal or beneficial interest(s) or provide documentation thereof shall be considered a violation of probation.

ACCEPTANCE

I have carefully read the above Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order and have fully discussed it with my attorney, Herbert L. Weinberg. I understand the stipulation and the effect it will have on my Pharmacist License. I enter into this Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently, and agree to be bound by the Decision and Order of the Board of Pharmacy.

20 **PARTIES**

21 1. Virginia Herold ("Complainant") brings this Accusation solely in her official capacity
22 as the Executive Officer of the Board of Pharmacy, Department of Consumer Affairs.

23 2. On or about December 9, 2011, the Board of Pharmacy issued Pharmacist License
24 Number RPH 66729 to Hebatullah Ahmed Taha ("Respondent"). The Pharmacist License was in
25 full force and effect at all times relevant to the charges brought herein and will expire on August
26 31, 2019, unless renewed.

1 JURISDICTION

2 3. This Accusation is brought before the Board of Pharmacy ("Board"), Department of
3 Consumer Affairs, under the authority of the following laws. All section references are to the
4 Business and Professions Code unless otherwise indicated.

5 4. Section 4300 of the Code states, in pertinent part:

6 "(a) Every license issued may be suspended or revoked.

7 "(b) The board shall discipline the holder of any license issued by the board, whose default
8 has been entered or whose case has been heard by the board and found guilty, by any of the
9 following methods:

10 "(1) Suspending judgment.

11 "(2) Placing him or her upon probation.

12 "(3) Suspending his or her right to practice for a period not exceeding one year.

13 "(4) Revoking his or her license.

14 "(5) Taking any other action in relation to disciplining him or her as the board in its
15 discretion may deem proper.

16 "....

17 "(e) The proceedings under this article shall be conducted in accordance with Chapter 5
18 (commencing with Section 11500) of Part 1 of Division 3 of the Government Code, and the board
19 shall have all the powers granted therein. The action shall be final, except that the propriety of
20 the action is subject to review by the superior court pursuant to Section 1094.5 of the Code of
21 Civil Procedure."

22 5. Section 4300.1 of the Code states:

23 "The expiration, cancellation, forfeiture, or suspension of a board-issued license by
24 operation of law or by order or decision of the board or a court of law, the placement of a license
25 on a retired status, or the voluntary surrender of a license by a licensee shall not deprive the board
26 of jurisdiction to commence or proceed with any investigation of, or action or disciplinary
27 proceeding against, the licensee or to render a decision suspending or revoking the license."

1 STATUTORY PROVISIONS

2 6. Section 4301 of the Code states:

3 “The board shall take action against any holder of a license who is guilty of unprofessional
4 conduct or whose license has been issued by mistake. Unprofessional conduct shall include, but is
5 not limited to, any of the following:

6 “. . . .

7 “(f) The commission of any act involving moral turpitude, dishonesty, fraud, deceit, or
8 corruption, whether the act is committed in the course of relations as a licensee or otherwise, and
9 whether the act is a felony or misdemeanor or not.

10 “(g) Knowingly making or signing any certificate or other document that falsely represents
11 the existence or nonexistence of a state of facts.

12 “. . . .

13 “(j) The violation of any of the statutes of this state, of any other state, or of the United
14 States regulating controlled substances and dangerous drugs. . . .”

15 “(o) Violating or attempting to violate, directly or indirectly, or assisting in or abetting the
16 violation of or conspiring to violate any provision or term of this chapter or of the applicable
17 federal and state laws and regulations governing pharmacy, including regulations established by
18 the board or by any other state or federal regulatory agency.

19 7. Section 4022 of the Code states

20 “‘Dangerous drug’ or ‘dangerous device’ means any drug or device unsafe for self-use in
21 humans or animals, and includes the following:

22 “(a) Any drug that bears the legend: ‘Caution: federal law prohibits dispensing without
23 prescription,’ ‘Rx only,’ or words of similar import.

24 “(b) Any device that bears the statement: ‘Caution: federal law restricts this device to sale
25 by or on the order of a _____,’ ‘Rx only,’ or words of similar import, the blank to be filled
26 in with the designation of the practitioner licensed to use or order use of the device.

27 “(c) Any other drug or device that by federal or state law can be lawfully dispensed only on
28 prescription or furnished pursuant to Section 4006.”

1 8. Section 4024, subdivision (a), of the Code states

2 “Except as provided in subdivision (b), ‘dispense’ means the furnishing of drugs or devices
3 upon a prescription from a physician, dentist, optometrist, podiatrist, veterinarian, or naturopathic
4 doctor pursuant to Section 3640.7, or upon an order to furnish drugs or transmit a prescription
5 from a certified nurse-midwife, nurse practitioner, physician assistant, naturopathic doctor
6 pursuant to Section 3640.5, or pharmacist acting within the scope of his or her practice.”

7 9. Section 4059, subdivision (a), of the Code states:

8 “(a) A person may not furnish any dangerous drug, except upon the prescription of a
9 physician, dentist, podiatrist, optometrist, veterinarian, or naturopathic doctor pursuant to Section
10 3640.7. A person may not furnish any dangerous device, except upon the prescription of a
11 physician, dentist, podiatrist, optometrist, veterinarian, or naturopathic doctor pursuant to Section
12 3640.7.”

13 10. Section 4063 of the Code states:

14 “No prescription for any dangerous drug or dangerous device may be refilled except upon
15 authorization of the prescriber. The authorization may be given orally or at the time of giving the
16 original prescription. No prescription for any dangerous drug that is a controlled substance may
17 be designated refillable as needed.”

18 11. Section 11150 of the Health and Safety Code states:

19 “No person other than a physician, dentist, podiatrist, or veterinarian, or naturopathic doctor
20 acting pursuant to Section 3640.7 of the Business and Professions Code, or pharmacist acting
21 within the scope of a project authorized under Article 1 (commencing with Section 128125) of
22 Chapter 3 of Part 3 of Division 107 or within the scope of Section 4052.1, 4052.2, or 4052.6 of
23 the Business and Professions Code, a registered nurse acting within the scope of a project
24 authorized under Article 1 (commencing with Section 128125) of Chapter 3 of Part 3 of Division
25 107, a certified nurse-midwife acting within the scope of Section 2746.51 of the Business and
26 Professions Code, a nurse practitioner acting within the scope of Section 2836.1 of the Business
27 and Professions Code, a physician assistant acting within the scope of a project authorized under
28 Article 1 (commencing with Section 128125) of Chapter 3 of Part 3 of Division 107 or Section

1 3502.1 of the Business and Professions Code, a naturopathic doctor acting within the scope of
2 Section 3640.5 of the Business and Professions Code, or an optometrist acting within the scope of
3 Section 3041 of the Business and Professions Code, or an out-of-state prescriber acting pursuant
4 to Section 4005 of the Business and Professions Code shall write or issue a prescription.”

5 12. Section 11171 of the Health and Safety Code states:

6 “No person shall prescribe, administer, or furnish a controlled substance except under the
7 conditions and in the manner provided by this division.”

8 REGULATORY PROVISIONS

9 13. California Code of Regulations, title 16, section 1714, subdivision (d), states:

10 “(d) Each pharmacist while on duty shall be responsible for the security of the prescription
11 department, including provisions for effective control against theft or diversion of dangerous
12 drugs and devices, and records for such drugs and devices. Possession of a key to the pharmacy
13 where dangerous drugs and controlled substances are stored shall be restricted to a pharmacist.”

14 14. California Code of Regulations, title 16, section 1716, states:

15 “Pharmacists shall not deviate from the requirements of a prescription except upon the prior
16 consent of the prescriber or to select the drug product in accordance with Section 4073 of the
17 Business and Professions Code. Nothing in this regulation is intended to prohibit a pharmacist
18 from exercising commonly-accepted pharmaceutical practice in the compounding or dispensing
19 of a prescription.”

20 COST RECOVERY PROVISION

21 15. Section 125.3 of the Code states, in pertinent part, that the Board may request the
22 administrative law judge to direct a licensee found to have committed a violation or violations of
23 the licensing act to pay a sum not to exceed the reasonable costs of the investigation and
24 enforcement of the case.

25 FACTS

26 16. Respondent was employed as a Pharmacist-in-Charge at WalMart Store No. 10-1914
27 (“WalMart”) from October 12, 2015, through July 26, 2016. WalMart terminated Respondent on
28 or about July 26, 2016.

1 17. WalMart's pharmacy would receive prescription refill requests by either a telephone
2 voice message, a computer/electronic application, or an in-person request. WalMart staff would
3 then send the original prescriber a request for authorization electronically, by fax, or by
4 telephone. Until the prescriber authorizes the refill, the refill request would remain in a Refill
5 Authorization Queue (the "Queue").

6 18. At some point during Respondent's employment with WalMart, a staff pharmacist
7 observed patient refill requests were authorized in a suspiciously quick timeframe by Respondent.
8 The pharmacist suspected Respondent was not performing her pharmacist duties in contacting
9 the prescriber to receive refill authorizations, but was approving the refills herself. Staff
10 pharmacists called various prescriber's offices and verified that the prescribers did not authorize
11 several refill authorizations completed by Respondent.

12 19. On or about August 14, 2017, two Board investigators interviewed Respondent
13 regarding her termination from WalMart. During that interview, Respondent admitted that every
14 shift she worked, she would pull prescriptions waiting in the Queue and enter into WalMart's
15 computer database on the customer's existing prescription a quantity of 90 pills plus three refills,
16 which equals a 12-month supply. Respondent admitted that she entered these refills without
17 obtaining prescriber approval. Respondent admitted that she began this practice in June 2016,
18 even though refills she improperly authorized were filled as early as February 6, 2016.
19 Respondent confirmed that she was responsible for the approximately 800 prescriptions from
20 June 1, 2016 to December 3, 2016, which WalMart had to reverse because Respondent
21 improperly authorized refills.

22 20. WalMart provided the Board with a list of approximately 1,316 prescriptions
23 Respondent initially added unauthorized refills to. WalMart reversed the payments for all of
24 these prescriptions. The prescriptions at issue were filled between February 6, 2016, and
25 December 3, 2016. The prescriptions at issue are summarized in the following chart:

1 **FIRST CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE**

2 **(Violation of Regulations Applicable to Pharmacy)**

3 21. Respondent is subject to disciplinary action under section 4301, subdivision (o), in
4 that Respondent violated sections of the California Code of Regulations, title 16, as follows:

5 a. **Section 1714, subdivision (d):** Between February 6, 2016, and July 27, 2016,
6 when Respondent was the Pharmacist-in-Charge at WalMart's Pharmacy, approximately 1,317
7 prescriptions were dispensed by WalMart's Pharmacy after Respondent added unauthorized
8 refills to prescriptions. Paragraphs 16-20, above, are incorporated by reference as though fully
9 stated herein.

10 b. **Section 1716:** Between June 1, 2016, and December 3, 2016, when Respondent
11 was the Pharmacist-in-Charge at WalMart's Pharmacy, approximately 793 prescriptions were
12 dispensed after Respondent added unauthorized refills to prescriptions. Respondent admitted that
13 she added the refills to prescriptions without obtaining authorization from the respective
14 prescribers. Paragraphs 16-20, above, are incorporated by reference as though fully stated herein.

15 **SECOND CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE**

16 **(Violation of Statutes Applicable to Pharmacy)**

17 22. Respondent is subject to disciplinary action under section 4301, subdivision (o), in
18 that Respondent violated California statutes applicable to pharmacy, as follows:

19 a. **Business and Professions Code Section 4024, subdivision (a) [Furnishing**
20 **Drugs Without Prescription]:** Between June 1, 2016, and July 27, 2016, when Respondent was
21 the Pharmacist-in-Charge at WalMart's Pharmacy, approximately 793 prescriptions were
22 dispensed by WalMart's Pharmacy after Respondent added refills to prescriptions without
23 obtaining authorization from the prescriber or the prescriber's authorized agent. Paragraphs 16-
24 20, above, are incorporated by reference as though fully stated herein.

25 b. **Business and Professions Code Section 4059, subdivision (a) [Furnishing**
26 **Dangerous Drugs Without Prescription]:** Between June 1, 2016, and July 27, 2016, when
27 Respondent was the Pharmacist-in-Charge at WalMart's Pharmacy, approximately 793
28 prescriptions were dispensed by WalMart's Pharmacy after Respondent added refills to

1 prescriptions without obtaining authorization from the prescriber or the prescriber's authorized
2 agent. Of the 793 prescriptions dispensed during this time period, 768 of them were for
3 dangerous drugs. Paragraphs 16-20, above, are incorporated by reference as though fully stated
4 herein.

5 c. **Business and Professions Code Section 4063 [Refilling Prescription Without**
6 **Prescriber Authorization]**: Between June 1, 2016, and July 27, 2016, when Respondent was the
7 Pharmacist-in-Charge at WalMart's Pharmacy, approximately 793 prescriptions were dispensed
8 by WalMart's Pharmacy after Respondent added refills to prescriptions without obtaining
9 authorization from the prescriber or the prescriber's authorized agent. Paragraphs 16-20, above,
10 are incorporated by reference as though fully stated herein.

11 d. **Health and Safety Code Section 11171 [Prescribing Controlled Substances in**
12 **Violation of Health and Safety Code]**: Between June 1, 2016, and July 27, 2016, when
13 Respondent was the Pharmacist-in-Charge at WalMart's Pharmacy, approximately 793
14 prescriptions were dispensed by WalMart's Pharmacy after Respondent added refills to
15 prescriptions without obtaining authorization from the prescriber or the prescriber's authorized
16 agent. Respondent was not a licensed prescriber when she added refills to the approximately 793
17 prescriptions. Of the prescriptions at issue, 11 of them involve controlled substances; the
18 controlled substances at issue are Lyrica (lines 6-7 and 934 of table in Paragraph 20, above) and
19 Vimpat (lines 250, 277, 514, 523, 856, 1160, and 1170 of table in Paragraph 20, above).
20 Paragraphs 16-20, above, are incorporated by reference as though fully stated herein.

21 **THIRD CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE**

22 **(Unprofessional Conduct – Dishonesty)**

23 23. Respondent is subject to disciplinary action under section 4301, subdivision (f), in
24 that between June 1, 2016, and July 27, 2016, while Respondent was employed as the
25 Pharmacist-in-Charge at WalMart's Pharmacy, Respondent committed acts involving moral
26 turpitude, dishonesty, fraud, or deceit, when she fraudulently documented that prescribers or their
27 authorized agents authorized the approval of refills on approximately 793 prescriptions.
28 Paragraphs 16-20, above, are incorporated by reference as though fully stated herein.

FOURTH CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

(Unprofessional Conduct – Falsifying Documents)

24. Respondent is subject to disciplinary action under section 4301, subdivision (g), in that between June 1, 2016, and July 27, 2016, while Respondent was employed as the Pharmacist-in-Charge at WalMart’s Pharmacy, Respondent fraudulently documented that prescribers or their authorized agents authorized the approval of refills on approximately 793 prescriptions. WalMart’s Pharmacy ultimately filled the prescriptions at issue and had to reverse the claims and payments for the prescriptions at issue. Paragraphs 16-20, above, are incorporated by reference as though fully stated herein.

FIFTH CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

(Unprofessional Conduct – Violation of Statutes Regarding Controlled Substances and Dangerous Drugs)

25. Respondent is subject to disciplinary action under section 4301, subdivision (j), in that between June 1, 2016, and July 27, 2016, while Respondent was employed as the Pharmacist-in-Charge at WalMart’s Pharmacy, Respondent violated United States and California statutes regulating controlled substances and dangerous drugs when she fraudulently documented that prescribers or their authorized agents authorized the approval of refills on approximately 793 prescriptions. Of the 793 prescriptions dispensed during this time period, 768 of them were for dangerous drugs. Of the prescriptions at issue, 11 of them involve controlled substances; the controlled substances at issue are Lyrica (lines 6-7 and 934 of table in Paragraph 20, above) and Vimpat (lines 250, 277, 514, 523, 856, 1160, and 1170 of table in Paragraph 20, above). WalMart’s Pharmacy ultimately filled the prescriptions at issue and had to reverse the claims and payments for the prescriptions at issue. Paragraphs 16-20, above, are incorporated by reference as though fully stated herein.

1 **SIXTH CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE**

2 **(Dispensing Drugs Without a Prescription)**

3 26. Respondent is subject to disciplinary action under section 4301, subdivision (g), in
4 that between June 1, 2016, and July 27, 2016, while Respondent was employed as the
5 Pharmacist-in-Charge at WalMart's Pharmacy, Respondent fraudulently documented that
6 prescribers or their authorized agents authorized the approval of refills on approximately 793
7 prescriptions. WalMart's Pharmacy ultimately filled the prescriptions at issue and had to reverse
8 the claims and payments for the prescriptions at issue. Paragraphs 16-20, above, are incorporated
9 by reference as though fully stated herein.


10 **PRAYER**
