11 The California State Board of Pharmacy's appearance and recommendation pursuant to
12 Penal Code section 23 came before this Court on August 20, 2015, at 8:30 a.m. Applicant
13 appeared through her attorneys of record, the California Attorney General's Office, by Deputy
14 Attorney General, Malissa N. Siemantel. Defendant appeared in person and was represented by
15 his attorney of record. The Deputy District Attorney of record appeared for the people.

16 The Court having considered the application, supporting documents and oral argument
17 and information presented at the hearing of this matter and finding good cause appearing to
18 support the applicant's request:

19 **IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT** Timothy Joseph O'Hara, as
20 an express condition of bail in matters pending in Sacramento County shall not perform any acts
21 for which a Pharmacy Technician Registration is required until the conclusion of the pending
22 criminal matters, and thereafter as a condition of probation until the anticipated administrative
23 action is completed.

24 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT** Defendant shall
25 inform all existing, prospective, or future employers of these conditions.
