
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23 The Court, having noted the appearance of the Office of Attorney General on behalf of the  
24 California Board of Pharmacy, Department of Consumer Affairs, State of California, and having  
25 heard and considered the moving papers, and oral argument, finds that good cause exists to issue  
26 an order pursuant to Penal Code Section 23 and Business and Professions Code section 320, that  
27 imposes appropriate restrictions on the Defendant's Pharmacy Technician Registration No. TCH  
28 39817,

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**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

1. Defendant ERIN MARIE YASIN, shall be prohibited from engaging, either directly or indirectly, in any activity for which a pharmacy technician license is required;
2. This condition shall remain in effect until further order of the Court; and
3.
