**ORDER GRANTING PETITION
FOR INTERIM SUSPENSION**

1. On August 31, 2013, this Petition for Interim Suspension Order (Petition) was heard before Administrative Law Judge Coren D. Wong, Office of Administrative Hearings, State of California, in Sacramento, California. Stephanie Alamo-Latif, Deputy Attorney General, represents petitioner Virginia Harold, Executive Officer of the Board of Pharmacy (Board), Department of Consumer Affairs, State of California. Attorney Ronald Kaldor of the Law Office of Ronald Kaldor represents respondent Wade Leslie Fullmer, who was also present.

2. Petitioner is seeking an interim order suspending Pharmacist License No. RPH 28731 issued to respondent pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 494. Evidence in the form of affidavits from Stephanie Alamo-Latif; Valerie Harris, Asset Protection Coordinator for Raley's; Troy Schweitz Human Resources Business Partner for Raley's; Gary Worman, Store Team Lead for Raley's in Turlock, California; Richard Galeazzi, Pharmacist in Charge for Raley's in Manteca, California; and Raymond Oneto, Pharmacist in Charge for Raley's in Modesto, California. The narrative supplemental report prepared by Ms. Harris and Mr. Fullmer's curriculum vitae were also received and reviewed. The matter was deemed submitted.

3. Having read and considered the Petition, Memorandum of Points and Authorities, affidavits, and documentary evidence submitted in support thereof, as well as oral argument presented hearing, and it appearing that petitioner has satisfactorily demonstrated by a preponderance of the evidence that:

a. Respondent, a pharmacist licensed by the State of California under Pharmacist License No. RPH 28731, has engaged in acts or omissions constituting a violation of the Pharmacy Law (Bus. & Prof. Code, § 4000 et. seq.).

b. Permitting respondent to continue to engage in the practice of pharmacy, or permitting him to continue in such practice without restriction, would endanger the public health, safety, or welfare.


4. Therefore, good cause appearing:

a. Pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 494, Pharmacist License No. RPH 28731 issued to respondent Wade Leslie Fullmer is hereby IMMEDIATELY SUSPENDED and respondent is IMMEDIATELY PROHIBITED from any practice as a pharmacist in the State of California, pending further order from an Administrative Law Judge of the Office of the Administrative Hearings or a court of competent jurisdiction.

b. The Board shall file an accusation within 15 days of the issuance of this interim suspension order. If respondent files a Notice of Defense, the hearing shall be held within 30 days of the Board's receipt of the Notice of Defense. A decision shall be rendered on the accusation no later than 30 days after submission of the matter. Failure to comply with any of the above requirements shall dissolve this interim order by operation of law.

IT IS SO ORDERED.


