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The court having noted the appearance of the California State Board of Pharmacy, Department of Consumer Affairs, and having heard and considered the moving papers, and oral argument, finds that good cause exists to issue an order pursuant to Penal Code section 23, that imposes appropriate restrictions on Defendant SYLVIA THERESA SOLORIO's pharmacy technician registration.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 1. SYLVIA THERESA SOLORIO shall be prohibited from engaging, either directly or indirectly, in any activity for which a pharmacy technician registration is required;
- 2. This condition shall remain in effect until there is a final disposition of this criminal case or until further order by this court;
- 3. The California State Board of Pharmacy shall be notified of any modification of this order. The notice shall be mailed within five days to: California State Board of Pharmacy, Department of Consumer Affairs, 1625 North Market Blvd., N219, Sacramento, CA 95834.
