11 23 came before this Court on October 21, 2016, at 8:30 a.m. or as soon thereafter as it could be
12 heard. Applicant appeared through her attorneys of record, the California Attorney General's
13 Office, by Deputy Attorney General, Kristina T. Jarvis. Defendant appeared in person and/or was

21 which registration as a pharmacy technician is required until the conclusion of the pending
22 criminal matters, and thereafter as a condition of probation until the anticipated administrative
23 action is completed.
