URGENT NOTICE

The U.S. Department of Justice, Drug Enforcement Administration, along with the Federal Bureau of Investigation, local, state, and other law enforcement agencies, is investigating the theft of more than 16 million dosage units of hydrocodone combination products. On Sunday, June 17, 2007, a tractor-trailer traveling from Watson Pharma's manufacturing plant in Corona, California to its distributor located in Gurnee, Illinois was stolen from a truck stop in Troy, Illinois.
