RE: PROPOSED ADDITION OF 1713 AND AMENDMENT OF SECTION 1717(e),
PRESCRIPTION DROP BOXES AND AUTOMATED DELIVERY DEVICES
NOTICE OF 15-DAY COMMENT PERIOD

In response to comments received during the 45-day public comment period (February 24, 2006 to April 10, 2006), the board is proposing to amend the text of section 1713 as reflected in the attachment.

- Changes released for the initial 45-day rulemaking are indicated in ~~strikeout~~ (i.e., ~~strikeout~~) for deletions and underscore (i.e., underscore) for additions.
- Proposed modifications that are the subject to this 15-day notice are indicated by double underscore (i.e., double underscore) for additions and ~~double strikeout~~ (i.e., ~~double strikeout~~) for deletions.

These changes were made at the board's April 26, 2006 meeting. Note: changes for this comment period were made only to section 1713. No additional changes were made to section 1717(e).
