### **LICENSING COMMITTEE REPORT**

The licensing committee did not meet this quarter.

#### **a. Consideration of Request to Recognize Chapman University School of Pharmacy**

#### **Attachment 1**

##### **Relevant Law**

Title 16 CCR 1719 states that a “recognized school of pharmacy” means a school accredited, or granted candidate status by the Accreditation Council for Pharmacy Education (ACPE) or otherwise recognized by the board.

Business and Professions Code Section 4208 establishes the pathways for licensure as an intern pharmacist including in enrollment in a school of pharmacy recognized by the board.

##### **Background**

There are three levels to full ACPE accreditation status for new schools of pharmacy: pre-candidate status, candidate status and full accreditation. New schools of pharmacy reach the various stages in their accreditation process as they reach various milestones. Pre-candidate status designates that a new program is progressing and students can be enrolled in the program. This means that the school is progressing to meet the ACPE accreditation standards but has not yet completed the process not graduated its first call. In such cases, the board must recognize the school or purposes of issuing an intern licenses to allow student to secure the training required for licensure.

Chapman University School of Pharmacy was granted pre-candidate status by the ACPE and the first call of students will be admitted in the fall of 2015. In order for the school’s students to progress through their education, intern licenses are needed.

##### **Board Consideration**

On April 13, 2015, the board received a request from Dr. Ronald Jordan asking for board recognition of its program for purposes of issuing intern pharmacist licenses to students enrolled in their program. A copy of the request is in **Attachment 1**.

**b. Competency Committee Report**

Examination Development

The Competency Committee workgroups continued to meet throughout 2015 for examination development. Both Competency Committee workgroups will meet for the annual meeting in August to discuss examination development as well as begin the transition to the new content outline of the examination. It is anticipated that the new content outline will go into effect in early 2016.

**c. Licensing Statistics July 1, 2014-June 30, 2015 and Three Year Comparison Data**

Licensing Statistics for July 2014-June 2015

During the 2014/15 fiscal year the board received almost 19,000 applications and issued 14,600 licenses. In addition the board responded to over 11,000 e-mail status inquiries, processed 1549 change of pharmacist-in-charge applications as well as 1262 other change notices (e.g., change in officers, directors, etc.) and updated over 12,000 name and address records. In addition the board denied 102 applications.

Three Year Comparison

*Applications Received*

The three year comparison reflects an overall increase of 11 percent in applications received. This includes a 20% increase in exam application, a 14 percent increase in intern pharmacist applications and a 67 percent increase in pharmacy applications. Pharmacy technician applications decreased by 22 percent.

*Licenses Issued*

This comparison also reflects an overall increase of 10% in licenses issued including a 14 percent increase in the number of pharmacist licenses issued, 26 percent increase in intern pharmacist licenses issued and a 69% increase in the number of pharmacy licenses issued. The board did experience a 3% decrease in the number of pharmacy technician licenses issued.

*Licensee Population*

The board has experienced a slight growth in its total licensee population, 3 percent. The greatest growth was in the sterile compounding licensing program which resulted from enactment of SB 294, the board sponsored legislation that significantly increased regulatory oversight of pharmacies that compound sterile products.

I write to request recognition of Chapman University School of Pharmacy (CUSP) located in Irvine, California by the California State Board of Pharmacy, pursuant to California Code of Regulations Section 1719.

The Doctor of Pharmacy program was reviewed by the Accreditation Council of Pharmacy Education through an onsite visit team in November 2014. Based upon the findings of this team, the ACPE Board of Directors granted pre-candidate status to CUSP at its January 21-25, 2015 meeting. The Precandidate status extends through Jun. 30, 2016 and a comprehensive on-site evaluation for consideration of advancing the Doctor of Pharmacy program from Precandidate to Candidate status will be scheduled during academic year 2015-2016 at a date yet to be determined.

Recognition of the CUSP Doctor of Pharmacy program by the California Board of Pharmacy will enable student pharmacists to apply for and attain their intern license so that they are adequately prepared to engage in experiential education activities and so they may work towards satisfying intern requirements while they are enrolled at CUSP as CUSP continues to advance towards achieving full candidate status with ACPE.

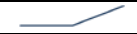

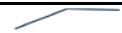
