## Recent news:

- The CPJE was administered November 22. <u>Additional test dates in 2021 and 2022</u> are available. To schedule an exam date within your eligibility period, go to <u>psiexams.com</u> or call (877) 392-6422.
- The Board released a <u>Notice of Proposed Action</u> to amend section 1715 to Title 16 of the California Code of Regulations related to Pharmacy/Hospital Self-Assessment Forms. The Board will accept written comments to the proposed text until December 27, 2021.
   Documents related to the proposed action are posted under <u>Pending Regulations</u>.

## Coming up:

- The Board is set to meet December 2. The meeting agenda and materials are posted under <u>Board Meetings</u>, in addition to the full schedule of Board meetings set for 2022.
- The CPJE will be administered December 10. Exam information is posted under
   <u>Pharmacist Examination and Licensure Information</u>. Participants must present <u>two</u>
   <u>forms of proper ID</u> and must complete an exit form during the checkout process.

All facilities, pharmacists, intern pharmacists, pharmacy technicians, and designated representatives are required to sign up for subscriber alerts for their license type within 60 days of obtaining a license or at the time of renewal. Licensees also must update their email addresses with the board within 30 days of change of email address.
