Recent news:

- The <u>Licensing Committee</u> met April 21, followed by the <u>Enforcement Committee</u> April 22. Links to the meeting agendas, materials, and webcasts are posted online.
- The <u>Communication and Public Education Committee</u> and the <u>Legislation and Regulation</u> <u>Committee</u> met April 29, followed by <u>Board</u> meetings April 29-30. Links to the meeting agendas, materials, and webcasts are posted online.
- The CPJE was administered to 276 pharmacist candidates April 30. The exam is set to be administered on <u>10 remaining dates in 2021</u>. To schedule an exam date within your eligibility period, go to <u>candidate.psiexams.com</u> or call (877) 392-6422.

Coming up:

- The Board is sponsoring <u>CE training on prescription drug abuse and diversion</u> on May 19. Registration for the event is closed. Information about future CE training will be posted online and sent to <u>email subscribers</u>.
- The CPJE will be was administered May 28. Exam information is posted online under "<u>Pharmacist Examination and Licensure Information</u>." Participants must have <u>two forms</u> <u>of proper ID</u> to take the exam and must complete an exit form during the checkout process.
- The Board's office will be closed Monday, May 31, in observance of Memorial Day, a state holiday.

- Updated draft versions of <u>self-assessment forms</u> for pharmacies and wholesalers are now posted online in addition to currently adopted versions. Although Board regulations require licensees to complete adopted self-assessment forms, completion of either adopted <u>or</u> draft versions is acceptable.
