Recent news:

- Jason Weisz of San Diego has joined the Board as a public member appointed by the California Senate Rules Committee. Mr. Weisz is a senior district representative with California Senate President Pro Tempore Toni G. Atkins.
- The Board met via teleconference September 17. A list of action items and links to a recording of the meeting webcast are posted on the <u>Board Meetings</u> webpage.
- The <u>September 2020 edition</u> of The Script is available online.
