Accord Healthcare Inc. is recalling a single lot of Glycopyrrolate Injection USP, 0.4mg/2mL, lot #M2013645. This recall is being carried out due to the incorrect blister foil being applied to a single lot of Glycopyrrolate Injection USP, 0.4mg/2mL. Note that the labeling on the carton and the vials themselves are correct, but the pre-printed foil is labeled incorrect.

This recall is to the retail/hospital level.
