

*The Board of Pharmacy has received notice of the following product recall. The Board strongly encourages pharmacies to immediately review their quality assurance and recall policies and procedures to determine if any corrective action is required.*

GE HealthCare has become aware that certain 100 ml bottles of Omnipaque (see batch numbers below) may have particles adhered to the polymer bottles. If these particles become dislodged and are not recognized before injection, they may pose a patient safety concern.

The occurrence of these particles is rare and when present they are visibly detectable. Use of this product for intra-arterial injections may result in particulate embolization into a small artery or arteriole. GE HealthCare has not received any customer complaints or reports of adverse events related to this issue.

We began shipping this product on October 30, 2025. This recall should be carried out to the wholesale and customer level.
