Intravenous administration of Sodium Bicarbonate in 5% Dextrose Injection 150mEq per 1,000 ml intended to be sterile that is not sterile could result in site specific infections as well as serious systemic infections which may be life-threatening. To date, SterRx has not received reports of any adverse events associated with this issue. This recall is to the hospital pharmacy level.
