18	1. Virginia Herold ("Complainant") brings this Accusation solely in her official capaci	ity
19	as the Executive Officer of the Board of Pharmacy, Department of Consumer Affairs.	
20	2. On or about January 22, 1993, the Board of Pharmacy issued Pharmacy Technician	
21	Registration Number TCH 3520 to Patricia Ann Carpio ("Respondent"). The Pharmacy	
22	Technician Registration Number was in full force and effect at all times relevant to the charges	
23	brought herein and will expire on February 29, 2012, unless renewed.	
24	<u>JURISDICTION</u>	
25	3. This Accusation is brought before the Board of Pharmacy ("Board"), Department of	<b>:</b>
26	Consumer Affairs, under the authority of the following laws. All section references are to the	
27	Business and Professions Code ("Code") unless otherwise indicated.	
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- 4. Section 4011 of the Code provides that the Board shall administer and enforce both the Pharmacy Law [Bus. & Prof. Code, § 4000 et seq.] and the Uniform Controlled Substances Act [Health & Safety Code, § 11000 et seq.].
- 5. Section 4300(a) of the Code provides that every license issued by the Board may be suspended or revoked.
  - 6. Section 4038 of the Code provides:
- "(a) 'Pharmacy technician' means an individual who assists a pharmacist in a pharmacy in the performance of his or her pharmacy related duties, as specified in Section 4115."

## STATUTORY AND REGULATORY PROVISIONS

7. Section 118, subdivision (b) of the Code provides:

"The suspension, expiration, or forfeiture by operation of law of a license issued by a board in the department, or its suspension, forfeiture, or cancellation by order of the board or by order of a court of law, or its surrender without the written consent of the board, shall not, during any period in which it may be renewed, restored, reissued, or reinstated, deprive the board of its authority to institute or continue a disciplinary proceeding against the licensee upon any ground provided by law or to enter an order suspending or revoking the license or otherwise taking disciplinary action against the licensee on any such ground.

8. Section 4059, subdivision (a) of the Code provides:

"A person may not furnish any dangerous drug, except upon the prescription of a physician, dentist, podiatrist, optometrist, veterinarian, or naturopathic doctor pursuant to Section 3640.7. A person may not furnish any dangerous device, except upon the prescription of a physician, dentist, podiatrist, optometrist, veterinarian, or naturopathic doctor pursuant to Section 3640.7."

9. Section 4063 of the Code provides, in pertinent part:

"No prescription for any dangerous drug or dangerous device may be refilled except upon authorization of the prescriber. The authorization may be given orally or at the time of giving the original prescription. No prescription for any dangerous drug that is a controlled substance may be designated refillable as needed."

acting pursuant to Section 3640.7 of the Business and Professions Code, or pharmacist acting within the scope of a project authorized under Article 1 (commencing with Section 128125) of Chapter 3 of Part 3 of Division 107 or within the scope of either Section 4052.1 or 4052.2 of the Business and Professions Code, a registered nurse acting within the scope of a project authorized under Article 1 (commencing with Section 128125) of Chapter 3 of Part 3 of Division 107, a certified nurse-midwife acting within the scope of Section 2746.51 of the Business and Professions Code, a nurse practitioner acting within the scope of Section 2836.1 of the Business and Professions Code, a physician assistant acting within the scope of a project authorized under Article 1 (commencing with Section 128125) of Chapter 3 of Part 3 of Division 107 or Section 3502.1 of the Business and Professions Code, a naturopathic doctor acting within the scope of Section 3640.5 of the Business and Professions Code, or an optometrist acting within the scope of Section 3041 of the Business and Professions Code, or an out-of-state prescriber acting pursuant to Section 4005 of the Business and Professions Code shall write or issue a prescription."

- 14. California Health and Safety Code section 11157 provides that no person shall issue a prescription that is false or fictitious in any respect.
- 15. California Health and Safety Code section 11158, subdivision (a) provides that, "Except as provided in Section 11159 or in subdivision (b) of this section, no controlled substance classified in Schedule II shall be dispensed without a prescription meeting the requirements of this chapter. Except as provided in Section 11159 or when dispensed directly to an ultimate user by a practitioner, other than a pharmacist or pharmacy, no controlled substance classified in Schedule III, IV, or V may be dispensed without a prescription meeting the requirements of this chapter."
  - 16. California Health and Safety Code section 11173 provides, in pertinent part:
- "(a) No person shall obtain or attempt to obtain controlled substances, or procure or attempt to procure the administration of or prescription for controlled substances, (1) by fraud, deceit, misrepresentation, or subterfuge; or (2) by the concealment of a material fact.
- (b) No person-shall-make a false statement in any prescription, order, report, or record, required by this division...."

technician at Pharmaca Integrative Pharmacy in Los Angeles, Respondent prepared a Refill Authorization Request form from a Dr. Peress, for patient S.W.<sup>1</sup> authorizing the refill of a prescription for thirty Vicoprofen tablets, as well as authorizing five additional refills. Respondent signed the Refill Authorization Request form. Dr. Peress did not authorize such a refill.

- 24. On or about May 26, 2009, while working in her capacity as a pharmacy technician at Pharmaca Integrative Pharmacy in Los Angeles, Respondent prepared a Refill Authorization Request form from a Dr. Akhondi, for patient S.W. authorizing the refill of a prescription for sixty Vicoprofen tablets, as well as authorizing five additional refills. Respondent signed the Refill Authorization Request form. Dr. Akhondi did not authorize such a refill.
- 25. Between September 2007 and January 2010, while working in her capacity as a pharmacy technician at Pharmaca Integrative Pharmacy in Los Angeles, Respondent dispensed eighty-five refills for hydrocodone/iburpofen 7.5/200 mg and twenty-four refills for Soma without valid prescriptions.
- 26. On or about January 14, 2010, Respondent was terminated from employment at Pharmaca Integrative Pharmacy and was arrested by officers with the Los Angeles Police Department.
- 27. Respondent admitted to dispensing controlled substances without valid prescriptions.

#### FIRST CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

## (Furnishing Drugs Without a Prescription)

28. Respondent's Pharmacy Technician Registration number is subject to disciplinary action under Code sections 4059 and 4301, subdivisions (j) and (o), in that Respondent furnished dangerous drugs, to wit Soma and Vicoprofen without a valid prescription. The circumstances surrounding the conduct are more particularly described in paragraphs 22 through 27, inclusive, above, and herein incorporated by reference.

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#### SECOND CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

### (Refill Prescription Without Prescriber's Authorization)

29. Respondent's Pharmacy Technician Registration number is subject to disciplinary action under Code sections 4063 and 4301, subdivisions (j) and (o), in that Respondent refilled a prescription for dangerous drugs, to wit Soma and Vicoprofen, without authorization of the prescriber. The circumstances surrounding the conduct are more particularly described in paragraphs 22 through 27, inclusive, above, and herein incorporated by reference.

## THIRD CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

#### (Fraud)

30. Respondent's Pharmacy Technician Registration number is subject to disciplinary action under Code section 4301, subdivision (f) in that Respondent committed a fraudulent act by forging prescriptions for dangerous drugs while working as a pharmacy technician. The circumstances surrounding the conduct are more particularly described in paragraphs 22 through 27, inclusive, above, and herein incorporated by reference.

## FOURTH CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

#### (Signing a Forged Document)

31. Respondent's Pharmacy Technician Registration number is subject to disciplinary action under Code section 4301, subdivision (g) in that Respondent committed signed a forged prescription refill authorization form knowing that the prescription refill authorization form was a forgery. The circumstances surrounding the conduct are more particularly described in paragraphs 22 through 27, inclusive, above, and herein incorporated by reference.

#### FIFTH CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

#### (Making False Prescription)

32. Respondent's Pharmacy Technician Registration number is subject to disciplinary action under Code section 4301, subdivisions (j) and (o), and California Health and Safety Code section 4324, in that Respondent falsely made a prescription for a drug, to wit Vicoprofen. The circumstances surrounding the conduct are more particularly described in paragraphs 22 through 27, inclusive, above, and herein incorporated by reference.

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### SIXTH CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

## (Unauthorized Writing of a Prescription)

33. Respondent's Pharmacy Technician Registration number is subject to disciplinary action under Code section 4301, subdivisions (j) and (o), and California Health and Safety Code section 11150, in that Respondent wrote a prescription for a drug, to wit Vicoprofen, even though she was not authorized by law to do so. The circumstances surrounding the conduct are more particularly described in paragraphs 22 through 27, inclusive, above, and herein incorporated by reference.

## SEVENTH CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

### (Issue a False Prescription)

34. Respondent's Pharmacy Technician Registration number is subject to disciplinary action under Code section 4301, subdivisions (j) and (o), and California Health and Safety Code section 11157, in that Respondent issued a prescription for drugs, to wit Soma and Vicoprofen, that was false. The circumstances surrounding the conduct are more particularly described in paragraphs 22 through 27, inclusive, above, and herein incorporated by reference.

#### **EIGHTH CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE**

## (Dispensed a Schedule III Controlled Substance Without a Prescription)

35. Respondent's Pharmacy Technician Registration number is subject to disciplinary action under Code section 4301, subdivisions (j) and (o), and California Health and Safety Code section 11158, in that Respondent dispensed a schedule III controlled substance, to wit Vicoprofen, without a prescription. The circumstances surrounding the conduct are more particularly described in paragraphs 22 through 27, inclusive, above, and herein incorporated by reference.

### NINTH CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

## (Procured Administration of Controlled Substance By Fraud)

36. Respondent's Pharmacy Technician Registration number is subject to disciplinary action under Code section 4301, subdivisions (j) and (o), and California Health and Safety Code section 11173, subdivision (a), in that Respondent procured the administration of a controlled

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1	substance by fraud. The circumstances surrounding the conduct are more particularly described in
2	paragraphs 22 through 27, inclusive, above, and herein incorporated by reference.
3	TENTH CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE
4	(Make a False Statement in a Prescription)
5	37. Respondent's Pharmacy Technician Registration number is subject to disciplinary
6	action under Code section 4301, subdivisions (j) and (o), and California Health and Safety Code
7	section 11173, subdivision (b), in that Respondent made a false statement in a prescription. The
8	circumstances surrounding the conduct are more particularly described in paragraphs 22 through
9	27, inclusive, above, and herein incorporated by reference.
10	<u>PRAYER</u>
11	WHEREFORE, Complainant requests that a hearing be held on the matters herein alleged,
12	and that following the hearing, the Board of Pharmacy issue a decision:
13	1. Revoking or suspending Pharmacy Technician Registration Number TCH 3520,
14	issued to Patricia Ann Carpio;
15	2. Ordering Patricia Ann Carpio to pay the Board of Pharmacy the reasonable costs of
16	the investigation and enforcement of this case, pursuant to Business and Professions Code section
17	125.3;
18	3. Taking such other and further action as deemed necessary and proper.
