22 Registration Number TCH 73620 to Gearl Dean Stevens (Respondent). The Pharmacy
23 Technician Registration expired on May 31, 2013, and has not been renewed.

24 **JURISDICTION**

25 3. This Accusation is brought before the Board of Pharmacy (Board), Department of
26 Consumer Affairs, under the authority of the following laws. All section references are to the
27 Business and Professions Code unless otherwise indicated.

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1 **FOURTH CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE**

2 **(Unprofessional Conduct-Furnishing Dangerous Drugs Without a Prescription)**

3 16. Respondent is subject to disciplinary action under Business and Professions Code
4 section 4301, subdivision (j) for violating Business and Professions Code section 4059(a) in that
5 she furnished dangerous drugs without a prescription when she diverted approximately 20 pills of
6 hydrocodone/apap 7.5-500mg tablets and approximately 330 pills of generic Fioricet, both for her
7 own use, while working as a pharmacy technician at CVS Pharmacy in Bakersfield from August
8 1, 2011 to July 20, 2012.

9 **PRAYER**


10 WHEREFORE, Complainant requests that a hearing be held on the matters herein alleged,
