. . . .

8. Code section 4302 states:

The board may deny, suspend, or revoke any license where conditions exist in relation to any person holding 10 percent or more of the ownership interest or where conditions exist in relation to any officer, director, or other person with management or control of the license that would constitute grounds for disciplinary action against a licensee.

9. Code section 4307 states:

- (a) Any person who has been denied a license or whose license has been revoked or is under suspension, or who has failed to renew his or her license while it was under suspension, or who has been a manager, administrator, owner, member, officer, director, associate, partner, or any other person with management or control of any partnership, corporation, trust, firm, or association whose application for a license has been denied or revoked, is under suspension or has been placed on probation, and while acting as the manager, administrator, owner, member, officer, director, associate, partner, or any other person with management or control had knowledge of or knowingly participated in any conduct for which the license was denied, revoked, suspended, or placed on probation, shall be prohibited from serving as a manager, administrator, owner, member, officer, director, associate, partner, or in any other position with management or control of a licensee as follows:
- (1) Where a probationary license is issued or where an existing license is placed on probation, this prohibition shall remain in effect for a period not to exceed five years.
- (2) Where the license is denied or revoked, the prohibition shall continue until the license is issued or reinstated.
- (b) "Manager, administrator, owner, member, officer, director, associate, partner, or any other person with management or control of a license" as used in this section and Section 4308, may refer to a pharmacist or to any other person who serves in such capacity in or for a licensee.
- (c) The provisions of subdivision (a) may be alleged in any pleading filed pursuant to Chapter 5 (commencing with Section 11500) of Part 1 of Division 3 of the Government Code. However, no order may be issued in that case except as to a person who is named in the caption, as to whom the pleading alleges the applicability of this section, and where the person has been given notice of the proceeding as required by Chapter 5 (commencing with Section 11500) of Part 1

of Division 3 of the Government Code. The authority to proceed as provided by this subdivision shall be in addition to the board's authority to proceed under Section 4339 or any other provision of law.

FACTUAL ALLEGATIONS

- 10. On August 12, 2005, the Board issued Pharmacy Technician License Number TCH 64078 to Respondent. The Pharmacy Technician License expired on May 31, 2019, and was not renewed. On November 8, 2017, the Board issued Intern Pharmacist Registration Number INT 41728 to Respondent. The Intern Pharmacist Registration expires on May 31, 2022.
- 11. From August 11, 2017 to December 31, 2017, Respondent was an officer (secretary) and 20% shareholder of White Cross Pharmacy #1 (PHY 50793) located at 21445 N. Sunrise Way, Ste. 100 in Palm Springs, California, 92262, and White Cross Pharmacy #1 (PHY 55765) located at 1717 East Vista Chino, Ste. B, in Palm Springs, California, 92262. On or about December 31, 2017, Respondent divested his shares of White Cross Pharmacy (PHY 55765); however, neither Respondent nor the other owners notified the Board of the change in the beneficial ownership interest. In addition, the Board discovered multiple violations of Pharmacy Law against White Cross Pharmacy. On July 1, 2021, the Board filed First Amended Accusation Numbers 6336, 6773 and 6775 against Respondent's Intern Pharmacist Registration, Pharmacy Technician License, and White Cross Pharmacy's permit, among others. Subsequently, Second Accusation Numbers 6336, 6773 and 6775 was filed and is currently pending before the Board. Second Accusation Numbers 6336, 6773 and 6775 is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

CAUSE FOR DENIAL

12. Respondent's application is subject to denial under Code sections 4300, subdivision (c), for unprofessional conduct, and 4301, subdivision (o), for violating section 4302 for conditions that would constitute grounds for disciplinary action against a licensee as set forth in paragraphs 10 and 11 above, as alleged in Second Amended Accusation Numbers 6336, 6773 and 6775, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.
