18	FINDINGS	OF FACT	
19			
20	1. On or about June 2, 2021, Complainant Anne Sodergren, in her official capacity as the Executive Officer of the Board of Pharmacy ("Board"), Department of Consumer Affairs,		
21	filed Accusation No. 7098 against Eliana Miranda ("Respondent") before the Board of Pharmacy.		
22	(Accusation attached as Exhibit A.)		
23	2. On or about August 27, 2008, the Board issued Pharmacy Technician Registration		
24 25	No. TCH 85035 to Respondent. The Pharmacy Technician Registration was in full force and		
26	effect at all times relevant to the charges brought in Accusation No. 7098 and will expire on May		
27	31, 2022, unless renewed.		
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- 3. On or about June 30, 2021, Respondent was served by Certified Mail copies of the Statement to Respondent, Accusation No. 7098, Statement to Respondent, Request for Discovery, Notice of Defense (2 copies) and Discovery Statutes (Government Code sections 11507.5, 11507.6, and 11507.7) at Respondent's address of record which, pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 4100, is required to be reported and maintained with the Board. Respondent's address of record was and is: 55960 Otis Avenue, Huntington Park, CA 90255.
- 4. Service of the Accusation was effective as a matter of law under the provisions of Government Code section 11505(c) and/or Business and Professions Code section 124.
 - 5. Government Code section 11506(c) states, in pertinent part:
 - (c) The respondent shall be entitled to a hearing on the merits if the respondent files a notice of defense . . . and the notice shall be deemed a specific denial of all parts of the accusation . . . not expressly admitted. Failure to file a notice of defense . . . shall constitute a waiver of respondent's right to a hearing, but the agency in its discretion may nevertheless grant a hearing.
- 6. The Board takes official notice of its records and the fact that Respondent failed to file a Notice of Defense within 15 days after service upon her of the Accusation, and therefore waived her right to a hearing on the merits of Accusation No. 7098.
 - 7. California Government Code section 11520(a) states, in pertinent part:
 - (a) If the respondent either fails to file a notice of defense . . . or to appear at the hearing, the agency may take action based upon the respondent's express admissions or upon other evidence and affidavits may be used as evidence without any notice to respondent
- 8. Pursuant to its authority under Government Code section 11520, the Board finds Respondent is in default. The Board will take action without further hearing and, based on the relevant evidence contained in the Default Decision Investigatory Evidence Packet in this matter, as well as taking official notice of all the investigatory reports, exhibits and statements contained therein on file at the Board's offices regarding the allegations contained in Accusation No. 7098, finds that the charges and allegations in Accusation No. 7098, are separately and severally, found to be true and correct by clear and convincing evidence.
- 9. The Board finds that the actual costs for Investigation and Enforcement are \$9,227.00 as of August 4, 2021.

DETERMINATION OF ISSUES 1 2 1. Based on the foregoing findings of fact, Respondent Eliana Miranda has subjected her Pharmacy Technician Registration No. TCH 85035 to discipline. 3 2. The agency has jurisdiction to adjudicate this case by default. 4 3. 5 The Board of Pharmacy is authorized to revoke Respondent's Pharmacy Technician Registration based upon the following violations alleged in the Accusation which are supported 6 7 by the evidence contained in the Default Decision Investigatory Evidence Packet in this case: Business and Professions Code section 4301, subdivisions (f) and (j) (Acts Involving 8 a. Moral Turpitude, Dishonesty, Fraud, Deceit, or Corruption). 9 Business and Professions Code sections 4301, subdivisions (j) and (o) b. 10 (Unprofessional Conduct/ Violation of Licensing Chapter). 11 Business and Professions Code sections 4301, subdivision (q), in conjunction with 12 c. 13 section 4060 (Unprofessional Conduct-Subverting an Investigation of the Board). /// 14 /// 15 16 /// 17 /// 18 /// 19 /// 20 /// 21 /// 22 /// 23 /// 24 /// 25 /// 26 /// 27 /// 28 ///

ORDER 1 IT IS SO ORDERED that Pharmacy Technician Registration No. TCH 85035, issued to 2 Respondent Eliana Miranda, is revoked. 3 Pursuant to Government Code section 11520, subdivision (c), Respondent may serve a 4 5 written motion requesting that the Decision be vacated and stating the grounds relied on within seven (7) days after service of the Decision on Respondent. The agency in its discretion may 6 7 vacate the Decision and grant a hearing on a showing of good cause, as defined in the statute.
