**STIPULATED SETTLEMENT AND
DISCIPLINARY ORDER FOR PUBLIC
REPROVAL**

[Bus. & Prof. Code § 495]

23 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED by and between the parties to the above-
24 entitled proceedings that the following matters are true:

25 **PARTIES**

26 1. Anne Sodergren (Complainant) is the Executive Officer of the Board of Pharmacy
27 (Board). She brought this action solely in her official capacity and is represented in this matter by
28

1 Rob Bonta, Attorney General of the State of California, by Nicole R. Trama, Deputy Attorney
2 General.

3 2. Respondent Evelyn Se Youn Yoon and Respondent Bestcare Pharmacy, Inc., doing
4 business as Bestcare Pharmacy (Respondents) are represented in this proceeding by attorney
5 Andre P. Vizcocho, R.Ph., J.D., whose address is: 9090 Irvine Center Drive, Irvine, CA 92618.

6 **JURISDICTION**

7 3. On or about September 20, 2017, the Board issued Pharmacist License No. RPH
8 77470 to Evelyn Se Youn Yoon (Respondent Yoon). The Pharmacist License was in full force
9 and effect at all times relevant to the charges brought in Accusation No. 7243 and will expire on
10 March 31, 2023, unless renewed.

11 4. On or about April 1, 2020, the Board issued Original Permit Number PHY 57674 to
12 Bestcare Pharmacy, Inc., to do business as Bestcare Pharmacy (Respondent Bestcare Pharmacy),
13 with Respondent Yoon as 100% Shareholder, Chief Executive Officer, President, Director,
14 Secretary and Treasurer/Chief Financial Officer. The Permit was in full force and effect at all
15 times relevant to the charges brought in Accusation No. 7243 and will expire on April 1, 2023,
16 unless renewed.

17 5. Accusation No. 7243 was filed before the Board and is currently pending against
18 Respondents. The Accusation and all other statutorily required documents were properly served
19 on Respondents on April 11, 2022. Respondents timely filed their Notice of Defense contesting
20 the Accusation. A copy of Accusation No. 7243 is attached as exhibit A and incorporated herein
21 by reference.

22 **ADVISEMENT AND WAIVERS**

23 6. Respondents have carefully read, fully discussed with counsel, and understand the
24 charges and allegations in Accusation No. 7243. Respondents have also carefully read, fully
25 discussed with counsel, and understand the effects of this Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary
26 Order for Public Reproval.

27 7. Respondents are fully aware of their legal rights in this matter, including the right to a
28 hearing on the charges and allegations in the Accusation; the right to confront and cross-examine

1 the witnesses against them; the right to present evidence and to testify on their own behalf; the
2 right to the issuance of subpoenas to compel the attendance of witnesses and the production of
3 documents; the right to reconsideration and court review of an adverse decision; and all other
4 rights accorded by the California Administrative Procedure Act and other applicable laws.

5 8. Respondents voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently waive and give up each and
6 every right set forth above.

7 **CULPABILITY**

8 9. Respondents admit the truth of each and every charge and allegation in Accusation
9 No. 7243.

10 10. Respondents agree that Pharmacist License Number RPH 77470 and Original Permit
11 Number PHY 57674 are subject to discipline and agree to be bound by the Disciplinary Order
12 below.

13 **CONTINGENCY**

14 11. This stipulation shall be subject to approval by the Board of Pharmacy. Respondents
15 understand and agree that counsel for Complainant and the staff of the Board of Pharmacy may
16 communicate directly with the Board regarding this stipulation and settlement, without notice to
17 or participation by Respondents or Respondent's counsel. By signing the stipulation,
18 Respondents understand and agree that they may not withdraw their agreement or seek to rescind
19 the stipulation prior to the time the Board considers and acts upon it. If the Board fails to adopt
20 this stipulation as its Decision and Order, the Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order for
21 Public Reprimand shall be of no force or effect, except for this paragraph, it shall be inadmissible in
22 any legal action between the parties, and the Board shall not be disqualified from further action
23 by having considered this matter.

24 12. The parties understand and agree that Portable Document Format (PDF) and facsimile
25 copies of this Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order for Public Reprimand, including PDF
26 and facsimile signatures thereto, shall have the same force and effect as the originals.

27 13. This Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order for Public Reprimand is intended by
28 the parties to be an integrated writing representing the complete, final, and exclusive embodiment

1 of their agreement. It supersedes any and all prior or contemporaneous agreements,
2 understandings, discussions, negotiations, and commitments (written or oral). This Stipulated
3 Settlement and Disciplinary Order for Public Reproval may not be altered, amended, modified,
4 supplemented, or otherwise changed except by a writing executed by an authorized representative
5 of each of the parties.

6 14. In consideration of the foregoing admissions and stipulations, the parties agree that
7 the Board may, without further notice or formal proceeding, issue and enter the following
8 Disciplinary Order:

9 **DISCIPLINARY ORDER**

10 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pharmacist License No. RPH 77470 issued to Respondent
11 Evelyn Se Youn Yoon (Respondent Yoon) and Original Permit Number PHY 57674 to Bestcare
12 Pharmacy, Inc., to do business as Bestcare Pharmacy (Respondent Bestcare Pharmacy) shall be
13 publicly reprovved by the Board of Pharmacy under Business and Professions Code section 495 in
14 resolution of Accusation No. 7243, attached as exhibit A.

15 **Ethics Course.** No later than sixty (60) days from the effective date of the public reprovall,
16 Respondent Yoon, at her own expense, shall enroll in a course in ethics, approved in advance by
17 the Board or its designee that complies with Title 16 California Code of Regulations section
18 1773.5. Respondent Yoon shall provide proof of enrollment upon request. Within five (5) days of
19 completion, Respondent Yoon shall submit a copy of the certificate of completion to the Board or
20 its designee. Failure to timely enroll in an approved ethics course and successfully complete it
21 within two (2) years, or failure to timely submit proof of completion to the Board or its designee
22 within two (2) years, shall be considered a violation of this Order.

23 **Apology Letter.** No later than sixty (60) days from the effective date of the public
24 reprovall, Respondent Yoon shall submit a letter of apology, addressed to the Board of Pharmacy,
25 about the lessons Respondent Yoon learned concerning the purchasing and offering for sale of
26 imported products that are legally deemed as prescription-only in the United States. Respondent
27 Yoon understands and agrees that her letter to the Board may be used by the Board or its designee
28 to educate and prepare other Board licensees. The Board or its designee may publish this letter,

1 including in *The Script*, or make other use thereof, and may edit the letter for length or clarity,
2 and/or redact portions of the letter. Failure to timely submit the letter to the Board or its designee
3 shall be considered a violation of this Order.

4 **No New Ownership or Management of Licensed Premises.** For a period of five (5) years
5 from the effective date of the public reproval, Respondents shall not acquire any new ownership,
6 legal or beneficial interest nor serve as a manager, administrator, member, officer, director,
7 trustee, associate, or partner of any additional business, firm, partnership, or corporation licensed
8 by the Board. If Respondents currently own or have any legal or beneficial interest in, or serve as
9 a manager, administrator, member, officer, director, trustee, associate, or partner of any business,
10 firm, partnership, or corporation currently or hereinafter licensed by the Board, Respondents may
11 continue to serve in such capacity or hold that interest, but only to the extent of that position or
12 interest as of the effective date of this Order. Violation of this restriction shall be considered a
13 violation of this order.

14 **Cost Recovery.** No later than sixty (60) days from the effective date of the public reproval,
15 Respondents shall pay \$3,500 to the Board for its costs associated with the investigation and
16 enforcement of this matter pursuant to Business and Professions Code Section 125.3.
17 Respondents shall be jointly and severally liable for payment of costs. If Respondents fail to pay
18 the Board costs as ordered, Respondents shall not be allowed to renew their Pharmacist License
19 and Original Pharmacy Permit until Respondents pay costs in full. In addition, the Board may
20 enforce this order for payment of its costs in any appropriate court, in addition to any other rights
21 the Board may have. Failure to timely submit payment of costs to the Board shall be considered a
22 violation of this Order.

23 **Full Compliance.** As a resolution of the charges in Accusation No. 7243, this stipulated
24 settlement is contingent upon Respondents' full compliance with all conditions of this Order. If
25 Respondents fail to satisfy any of these conditions, such failure to comply constitutes cause for
26 discipline, including outright revocation, of Respondent Yoon's Pharmacist License No. RPH
27 77470 and Respondent Bestcare's Original Permit Number PHY 57674.



24 **PARTIES**

25 1. Anne Sodergren (Complainant) brings this Accusation solely in her official capacity
26 as the Executive Officer of the Board of Pharmacy, Department of Consumer Affairs.

27 2. On or about September 20, 2017, the Board of Pharmacy issued Pharmacist License
28 Number RPH 77470 to Evelyn Se Youn Yoon (Respondent Yoon). The Pharmacist License was

1 in full force and effect at all times relevant to the charges brought herein and will expire on
2 March 31, 2023, unless renewed.

3 3. On or about April 1, 2020, the Board of Pharmacy issued Original Permit Number
4 PHY 57674 to Bestcare Pharmacy, Inc., to do business as Bestcare Pharmacy (Respondent
5 Bestcare Pharmacy), with Respondent Yoon as 100% Shareholder, Chief Executive Officer,
6 President, Director, Secretary and Treasurer/Chief Financial Officer. The Permit was in full force
7 and effect at all times relevant to the charges brought herein and will expire on April 1, 2023,
8 unless renewed.

9 **JURISDICTION**

10 4. This Accusation is brought before the Board of Pharmacy (Board), Department of
11 Consumer Affairs, under the authority of the following laws. All section references are to the
12 Business and Professions Code (Code) unless otherwise indicated.

13 5. Section 4011 of the Code provides that the Board shall administer and enforce both
14 the Pharmacy Law (Bus. & Prof. Code, § 4000 *et seq.*) and the Uniform Controlled Substances
15 Act (Health & Safety Code, § 11000 *et seq.*).

16 6. Code section 4300, subdivision (a) provides that every license issued by the Board
17 may be suspended or revoked.

18 7. Code section 4300.1 states:

19 The expiration, cancellation, forfeiture, or suspension of a board-issued license
20 by operation of law or by order or decision of the board or a court of law, the
21 placement of a license on a retired status, or the voluntary surrender of a license by a
22 licensee shall not deprive the board of jurisdiction to commence or proceed with any
investigation of, or action or disciplinary proceeding against, the licensee or to render
a decision suspending or revoking the license.

23 **STATUTORY PROVISIONS**

24 8. Code section 4022 states:

25 “Dangerous drug” or “dangerous device” means any drug or device unsafe
26 for self-use in humans or animals, and includes the following:

27 (a) Any drug that bears the legend: “Caution: federal law prohibits
28 dispensing without prescription,” “Rx only,” or words of similar import.

1 (b) Any device that bears the statement: "Caution: federal law restricts this
2 device to sale by or on the order of a ____" "Rx only," or words of similar import,
the blank to be filled in with the designation of the practitioner licensed to use or
order use of the device.

3 (c) Any other drug or device that by federal or state law can be lawfully
4 dispensed only on prescription or furnished pursuant to Section 4006.

5 9. Code section 4113, subdivision (c) states:

6 The pharmacist-in-charge shall be responsible for a pharmacy's compliance
7 with all state and federal laws and regulations pertaining to the practice of pharmacy.

8 10. Code section 4169 states:

9 (a) A person or entity shall not do any of the following:

10 ...

11 (3) Purchase, trade, sell, or transfer dangerous drugs that the person knew or
12 reasonably should have known were misbranded, as defined in Section 111335 of the
Health and Safety Code.

13

14 11. Code section 4301 states in pertinent part:

15 The board shall take action against any holder of a license who is guilty of
16 unprofessional conduct or whose license has been procured by fraud or
misrepresentation or issued by mistake. Unprofessional conduct shall include, but is
17 not limited to, any of the following:

18 ...

19 (j) The violation of any of the statutes of this state, or any other state, or of the
United States regulating controlled substances and dangerous drugs

20 ...

21 (o) Violating or attempting to violate, directly or indirectly, or assisting in or
22 abetting the violation of or conspiring to violate any provision or term of this chapter
or of the applicable federal and state laws and regulations governing pharmacy,
23 including regulations established by the board or any other state or federal regulatory
agency.

24 ...

25 12. Code section 4307, subdivision (a) states:

26 Any person who has been denied a license or whose license has been revoked
or is under suspension, or who has failed to renew his or her license while it was
27 under suspension, or who has been a manager, administrator, owner member, officer,
director, associate, or partner of any partnership, corporation, firm, or association
28 whose application for a license has been denied or revoked, is under suspension or

has been placed on probation, and while acting as the manger, administrator, owner, member, officer, director, associate, or partner had knowledge or knowingly participated in any conduct for which the license was denied, revoked, suspended, or placed on probation, shall be prohibited from serving as a manger, administrator, owner, member, officer, director, associate, or partner of a licensee as follows:

(1) Where a probationary license is issued or where an existing license is placed on probation, this prohibition shall remain in effect for a period not to exceed five years.

(2) Where the license is denied or revoked, the prohibition shall continue until the license is issued or reinstated.

13. Health and Safety Code section 111335 states:

Any drug or device is misbranded if its labeling or packaging does not conform to the requirements of Chapter 4 (commencing with Section 110290).

14. Health and Safety Code section 111380 states:

Any drug is misbranded if it purports to be a drug that is recognized in an official compendium and it is not packaged and labeled as prescribed in the official compendium. The method of packaging, however, may be modified with the consent of the department.

15. Health and Safety Code section 111440 states:

It is unlawful for any person to manufacture, sell, deliver, hold, or offer for sale any drug or device that is misbranded.

COST RECOVERY

16. Section 125.3 of the Code provides, in pertinent part, that the Board may request the administrative law judge to direct a licentiate found to have committed a violation or violations of the licensing act to pay a sum not to exceed the reasonable costs of the investigation and enforcement of the case.

DRUGS

17. Albenza, the brand name for the generic albendazole, is a dangerous drug pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 4022.

18. Betamethasone/clotrimazole is a dangerous drug pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 4022.

19. Betamethasone/neomycin is a dangerous drug pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 4022.

20. Betamethasone/gentamicin is a dangerous drug pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 4022.

21. Flutelmium, the brand name for the generic flubendazole, is a dangerous drug pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 4022.

22. Spectazole, the brand name for the generic econazole, is a dangerous drug pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 4022.

23. Zovirax, the brand name for the generic acyclovir, is a dangerous drug pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 4022.

FACTUAL ALLEGATIONS

24. At all times mentioned herein, Respondent Yoon has been the Pharmacist-in-Charge (PIC) at Respondent Bestcare Pharmacy, located in Buena Park, California.

25. On September 2, 2021, a Board of Pharmacy inspector conducted a routine inspection of Respondent Bestcare Pharmacy. When the inspector entered the premises, she noticed Respondent Yoon and a pharmacy technician go into the back room and open the door, in an apparent attempt to remove something from the pharmacy. The inspector instructed Respondent Yoon and the technician to bring the items that were removed back into the pharmacy for inspection. The technician brought the inspector a banker box that was half full of Korean labeled medications.

26. The inspector conducted an inventory of the drugs in the box. Respondent Yoon assisted the inspector with the translation of the drug names from Korean to English. The box contained the following drugs: 13 boxes of Albendazole (400 mg); 19 boxes of Acyclovir 5%; 8 boxes of betamethasone/clotrimazole; 12 boxes of prednisolone/neomycin; 1 box of betamethasone/gentamicin; 5 boxes of econazole solution and 17 boxes of flubendazole. All of the drugs are classified as dangerous drugs and require a prescription in the United States; however, Respondent Yoon informed the inspector that she sold them over-the-counter to her customers since they are sold over-the-counter in Korea. The packaging and labeling of these drugs did not conform with the requirements of the official compendium. The inspector embargoed the drugs and later ordered the drugs to be destroyed. Respondent Yoon complied

1 and provided evidence that the Korean labeled drugs were returned for destruction with a reverse
2 distributor.

3 **FIRST CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE**

4 **(Selling Misbranded Drugs)**

5 27. Respondents are subject to disciplinary action under Business and Professions Code
6 section 4301, subdivisions (j) and (o), for selling misbranded drugs in violation of Business and
7 Professions Code section 4169, subdivision (a)(3) and Health and Safety Code section 111440,
8 111335 and 111380 as set forth in paragraphs 24 through 26, incorporated herein.

9 **OTHER MATTERS**

10 28. Pursuant to Code section 4307, if discipline is imposed on Original Pharmacy Permit
11 Number PHY 57674, issued to Bestcare Pharmacy, Inc., DBA Bestcare Pharmacy, Respondent
12 Bestcare Pharmacy shall be prohibited from serving as a manager, administrator, owner, member,
13 officer, director, associate, or partner of a licensee for five years if Original Pharmacy Permit
14 Number PHY 57674, issued to Bestcare Pharmacy, Inc., DBA Bestcare Pharmacy is reinstated if
15 it is revoked.

16 29. Pursuant to Code section 4307, if discipline is imposed on Original Pharmacy Permit
17 Number PHY 57674, issued to Bestcare Pharmacy, Inc., DBA Bestcare Pharmacy, while
18 Respondent Yoon has been an officer and owner and had knowledge of or knowingly participated
19 in any conduct for which the licensee was disciplined, Respondent Yoon shall be prohibited from
20 serving as a manager, administrator, owner, member, officer, director, associate, or partner of a
21 licensee for five years if Original Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 57674, issued Bestcare
22 Pharmacy, Inc., DBA Bestcare Pharmacy is reinstated if it is revoked.

23 30. Pursuant to Code section 4307, if discipline is imposed on Pharmacist License
24 Number RPH 77470, issued to Evelyn Se Youn Yoon, Respondent Yoon shall be prohibited from
25 serving as a manager, administrator, owner, member, officer, director, associate, or partner of a
26 licensee for five years if Pharmacist License Number RPH 77470 is placed on probation or until
27 Pharmacist License Number RPH 77470 is reinstated if it is revoked.

PRAYER

WHEREFORE, Complainant requests that a hearing be held on the matters herein alleged, and that following the hearing, the Board of Pharmacy issue a decision:

1. Revoking or suspending Pharmacist License Number RPH 77470, issued to Evelyn Se Youn Yoon;

2. Revoking or suspending Original Permit Number PHY 57674, issued Bestcare Pharmacy, Inc., DBA Bestcare Pharmacy;

3. Prohibiting Bestcare Pharmacy, Inc., DBA Bestcare Pharmacy from serving as a manager, administrator, owner, member, officer, director, associate, or partner of a licensee for five years if Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 57674 is placed on probation or until Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 57674 is reinstated if Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 57674 issued to Bestcare Pharmacy, Inc., DBA Bestcare Pharmacy is revoked;

4. Prohibiting Evelyn Se Youn Yoon from serving as a manager, administrator, owner, member, officer, director, associate, or partner of a licensee for five years if Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 57674 is placed on probation or until Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 57674 is reinstated if Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 57674 issued to Bestcare Pharmacy, Inc., DBA Bestcare Pharmacy, is revoked;

5. Prohibiting Evelyn Se Youn Yoon from serving as a manager, administrator, owner, member, officer, director, associate, or partner of a licensee for five years if Pharmacist License Number RPH 77470 is placed on probation or until Pharmacist License Number RPH 77470 is reinstated if Pharmacist License Number RPH 77470 issued to Evelyn Se Youn Yoon is revoked;

6. Ordering Respondents to pay the Board of Pharmacy the reasonable costs of the investigation and enforcement of this case, pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 125.3; and,
