10	March 31, 2023, unless renewed.
11	4. On or about April 1, 2020, the Board issued Original Permit Number PHY 57674 to
12	Bestcare Pharmacy, Inc., to do business as Bestcare Pharmacy (Respondent Bestcare Pharmacy),
13	with Respondent Yoon as 100% Shareholder, Chief Executive Officer, President, Director,
14	Secretary and Treasurer/Chief Financial Officer. The Permit was in full force and effect at all
15	times relevant to the charges brought in Accusation No. 7243 and will expire on April 1, 2023,
16	unless renewed.
17	5. Accusation No. 7243 was filed before the Board and is currently pending against
18	Respondents. The Accusation and all other statutorily required documents were properly served
19	on Respondents on April 11, 2022. Respondents timely filed their Notice of Defense contesting
20	the Accusation. A copy of Accusation No. 7243 is attached as exhibit A and incorporated herein

14	11. This stipulation shall be subject to approval by the Board of Pharmacy. Respondents	
15	understand and agree that counsel for Complainant and the staff of the Board of Pharmacy may	
16	communicate directly with the Board regarding this stipulation and settlement, without notice to	
17	or participation by Respondents or Respondent's counsel. By signing the stipulation,	
18	Respondents understand and agree that they may not withdraw their agreement or seek to rescind

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DISCIPLINARY ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pharmacist License No. RPH 77470 issued to Respondent
Evelyn Se Youn Yoon (Respondent Yoon) and Original Permit Number PHY 57674 to Bestcare
Pharmacy, Inc., to do business as Bestcare Pharmacy (Respondent Bestcare Pharmacy) shall be
publicly reproved by the Board of Pharmacy under Business and Professions Code section 495 in
resolution of Accusation No. 7243, attached as exhibit A.

Ethics Course. No later than sixty (60) days from the effective date of the public reproval, 15 Respondent Yoon, at her own expense, shall enroll in a course in ethics, approved in advance by 16 the Board or its designee that complies with Title 16 California Code of Regulations section 17 1773.5. Respondent Yoon shall provide proof of enrollment upon request. Within five (5) days of 18 19 completion, Respondent Yoon shall submit a copy of the certificate of completion to the Board or its designee. Failure to timely enroll in an approved ethics course and successfully complete it 2021 within two (2) years, or failure to timely submit proof of completion to the Board or its designee within two (2) years, shall be considered a violation of this Order. 22

Apology Letter. No later than sixty (60) days from the effective date of the public
reproval, Respondent Yoon shall submit a letter of apology, addressed to the Board of Pharmacy,
about the lessons Respondent Yoon learned concerning the purchasing and offering for sale of
imported products that are legally deemed as prescription-only in the United States. Respondent
Yoon understands and agrees that her letter to the Board may be used by the Board or its designee
to educate and prepare other Board licensees. The Board or its designee may publish this letter,

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including in *The Script*, or make other use thereof, and may edit the letter for length or clarity, and/or redact portions of the letter. Failure to timely submit the letter to the Board or its designee shall be considered a violation of this Order.

- No New Ownership or Management of Licensed Premises. For a period of five (5) years 4 from the effective date of the public reproval, Respondents shall not acquire any new ownership, 5 legal or beneficial interest nor serve as a manager, administrator, member, officer, director, 6 trustee, associate, or partner of any additional business, firm, partnership, or corporation licensed 7 by the Board. If Respondents currently own or have any legal or beneficial interest in, or serve as 8 a manager, administrator, member, officer, director, trustee, associate, or partner of any business, 9 10 firm, partnership, or corporation currently or hereinafter licensed by the Board, Respondents may continue to serve in such capacity or hold that interest, but only to the extent of that position or 11 interest as of the effective date of this Order. Violation of this restriction shall be considered a 12 violation of this order. 13
- **Cost Recovery**. No later than sixty (60) days from the effective date of the public reproval, 14 Respondents shall pay \$3,500 to the Board for its costs associated with the investigation and 15 enforcement of this matter pursuant to Business and Professions Code Section 125.3. 16
- Respondents shall be jointly and severally liable for payment of costs. If Respondents fail to pay 17 the Board costs as ordered, Respondents shall not be allowed to renew their Pharmacist License 18 19 and Original Pharmacy Permit until Respondents pay costs in full. In addition, the Board may enforce this order for payment of its costs in any appropriate court, in addition to any other rights 2021 the Board may have. Failure to timely submit payment of costs to the Board shall be considered a violation of this Order. 22
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Full Compliance. As a resolution of the charges in Accusation No. 7243, this stipulated 24 settlement is contingent upon Respondents' full compliance with all conditions of this Order. If Respondents fail to satisfy any of these conditions, such failure to comply constitutes cause for 25 discipline, including outright revocation, of Respondent Yoon's Pharmacist License No. RPH 26 77470 and Respondent Bestcare's Original Permit Number PHY 57674. 27

Flutelmium, the brand name for the generic flubendazole, is a dangerous drug 3 pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 4022. 4 22. Spectazole, the brand name for the generic econazole, is a dangerous drug pursuant to 5 Business and Professions Code section 4022. 6 23. Zovirax, the brand name for the generic acyclovir, is a dangerous drug pursuant to 7 Business and Professions Code section 4022. 8 FACTUAL ALLEGATIONS 9 24. At all times mentioned herein, Respondent Yoon has been the Pharmacist-in-Charge 10 (PIC) at Respondent Bestcare Pharmacy, located in Buena Park, California. 11 25. On September 2, 2021, a Board of Pharmacy inspector conducted a routine inspection 12 of Respondent Bestcare Pharmacy. When the inspector entered the premises, she noticed 13 14 Respondent Yoon and a pharmacy technician go into the back room and open the door, in an apparent attempt to remove something from the pharmacy. The inspector instructed Respondent 15 Yoon and the technician to bring the items that were removed back into the pharmacy for 16 inspection. The technician brought the inspector a banker box that was half full of Korean 17 labeled medications. 18 26. The inspector conducted an inventory of the drugs in the box. Respondent Yoon 19 assisted the inspector with the translation of the drug names from Korean to English. The box 20 21 contained the following drugs: 13 boxes of Albendazole (400 mg); 19 boxes of Acyclovir 5%; 8 boxes of betamethasone/clotrimazole; 12 boxes of prednisolone/neomycin; 1 box of 22 betamethasone/gentamicin; 5 boxes of econazole solution and 17 boxes of flubendazole. All of 23 24 the drugs are classified as dangerous drugs and require a prescription in the United States; however, Respondent Yoon informed the inspector that she sold them over-the-counter to her 25 customers since they are sold over-the-counter in Korea. The packaging and labeling of these 26 drugs did not conform with the requirements of the official compendium. The inspector 27 embargoed the drugs and later ordered the drugs to be destroyed. Respondent Yoon complied 28 5 (EVELYN SE YOUN YOON and BESTCARE PHARMACY, INC., DBA BESTCARE PHARMACY)

ACCUSATION

and provided evidence that the Korean labeled drugs were returned for destruction with a reverse 1 2 distributor.
