18	IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGR	EED by and between the parties to the above-	
19	entitled proceedings that the following matters are true:		
20	<u>PARTIES</u>		
21	1. Anne Sodergren (Complainant) is the Executive Officer of the Board of Pharmacy		
22	(Board). She brought this action solely in her official capacity and is represented in this matter by		
23	Rob Bonta, Attorney General of the State of California, by Leslie E. Brast, Deputy Attorney		
24	General.		
25	2. Oanh Nhu Nguyen (Respondent) is representing herself in this proceeding and has		
26	chosen not to exercise her right to be represented by counsel.		
27	3. On or about August 21, 2003, the Board issued Pharmacist License No. RPH 54585		
28	to Respondent. The Pharmacist License was in full force and effect at all times relevant to the

- 10. This stipulation shall be subject to approval by the Board. Respondent understands and agrees that counsel for Complainant and Board staff may communicate directly with the Board regarding this stipulation and surrender, without notice to or participation by Respondent. By signing the stipulation, Respondent understands and agrees that she may not withdraw her agreement or seek to rescind the stipulation prior to the time the Board considers and acts upon it. If the Board fails to adopt this stipulation as its Decision and Order, the Stipulated Surrender and Disciplinary Order shall be of no force or effect, except for this paragraph; it shall be inadmissible in any legal action between the parties; and the Board shall not be disqualified from further action by having considered this matter.
- 11. The parties understand and agree that Portable Document Format (PDF) and facsimile copies of this Stipulated Surrender of License and Order, including PDF and facsimile signatures thereto, shall have the same force and effect as the originals.
- 12. This Stipulated Surrender of License and Order is intended by the parties to be an integrated writing representing the complete, final, and exclusive embodiment of their agreement. It supersedes any and all prior or contemporaneous agreements, understandings, discussions, negotiations, and commitments (written or oral). This Stipulated Surrender of License and Order may not be altered, amended, modified, supplemented, or otherwise changed except by a writing executed by an authorized representative of each of the parties.
- 13. In consideration of the foregoing admissions and stipulations, the parties agree that the Board may, without further notice or formal proceeding, issue and enter the following Order:

<u>ORDER</u>

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pharmacist License No. RPH 54585, issued to Respondent Oanh Nhu Nguyen, is surrendered and accepted by the Board.

 The surrender of Respondent's Pharmacist License, and the acceptance of the surrendered license by the Board, shall constitute the imposition of discipline against Respondent.
 This stipulation constitutes a record of the discipline and shall become a part of Respondent's

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ACCEPTANCE

I have carefully read the Stipulated Surrender of License and Order. I understand the stipulation and the effect it will have on my Pharmacist License. I enter into this Stipulated

license history with the Board. Respondent understands and acknowledges that for purposes of Business and Professions Code section 4307, this stipulated surrender is treated the same as a revocation of licensure.

- 2. Respondent shall lose all rights and privileges as a Licensed Pharmacist in California as of the effective date of the Board's Decision and Order.
- 3. Respondent shall cause to be delivered to the Board her pocket license and, if one was issued, her wall certificate on or before the effective date of the Decision and Order.
- 4. If Respondent ever applies for licensure or petitions for reinstatement in the State of California, the Board shall treat it as a new application for licensure. Respondent must comply with all the laws, regulations and procedures for licensure in effect at the time the application or petition is filed, and all of the charges and allegations contained in Accusation No. 7475 shall be deemed to be true, correct and admitted by Respondent when the Board determines whether to grant or deny the application or petition.
- 5. Respondent shall not apply for licensure or petition for reinstatement for three (3) years from the effective date of this Decision and Order.
- 6. Respondent shall pay the agency its costs of investigation and enforcement in the amount of \$11,403.50 prior to issuance of a new or reinstated license.
- If Respondent should ever apply or reapply for a new license or certification, or 7. petition for reinstatement of a license, by any other health care licensing agency in the State of California, all of the charges and allegations contained in Accusation No. 7475 shall be deemed to be true, correct, and admitted by Respondent for the purpose of any Statement of Issues or any other proceeding seeking to deny or restrict licensure.

21	2. On or about August 21, 2003, the Board issued Pharmacist License Number RPH		
22	54585 to Oanh Nhu Nguyen (Respondent). The Pharmacist License was in full force and effect a		
23	all times relevant to the charges brought herein an	d will expire on September 30, 2024, unless	
24	renewed.		
25	<u>JURISDICTION</u>		
26	3. This Accusation is brought before the Board under the authority of the following		
27	laws. All section references are to the Business and Professions Code (Code) unless otherwise		
28	indicated.		
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or is under suspension, or who has failed to renew his or her license while it was

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under suspension, or who has been a manager, administrator, owner member, officer, director, associate, or partner of any partnership, corporation, firm, or association whose application for a license has been denied or revoked, is under suspension or has been placed on probation, and while acting as the manger, administrator, owner, member, officer, director, associate, or partner had knowledge or knowingly participated in any conduct for which the license was denied, revoked, suspended, or placed on probation, shall be prohibited from serving as a manager, administrator, owner, member, officer, director, associate, or partner of a licensee as follows:

- (1) Where a probationary license is issued or where an existing license is placed on probation, this prohibition shall remain in effect for a period not to exceed five years.
- (2) Where the license is denied or revoked, the prohibition shall continue until the license is issued or reinstated.
- 9. Code section 4059 (a) prohibits furnishing of any dangerous drug or dangerous device except upon the prescription of an authorized prescriber.
- 10. Code section 4060 provides, in pertinent part, that no person shall possess any controlled substance, except that furnished upon a valid prescription/drug order.
- 11. Health and Safety Code section 11170 provides that no person shall prescribe, administer, or furnish a controlled substance for himself or herself.
- 12. Health and Safety Code section 11173, subdivision (a), provides that no person shall obtain or attempt to obtain controlled substances, or procure or attempt to procure the administration of or prescription for controlled substances, (1) by fraud, deceit, misrepresentation, or subterfuge; or (2) by the concealment of a material fact.
- 13. Health and Safety Code section 11350, in pertinent part, makes it unlawful to possess any controlled substance listed in Schedule II (Health and Safety Code section 11055), subdivision (b) or (c), or any narcotic drug in Schedules III-V, absent a valid prescription.

REGULATORY PROVISIONS

14. California Code of Regulations, title 16, section 1770, states:

For the purpose of denial, suspension, or revocation of a personal or facility license pursuant to Division 1.5 (commencing with Section 475) of the Business and Professions Code, a crime or act shall be considered substantially related to the qualifications, functions or duties of a licensee or registrant if to a substantial degree it evidences present or potential unfitness of a licensee or registrant to perform the functions authorized by his license or registration in a manner consistent with the public health, safety, or welfare.

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Code section 125.3 provides, in pertinent part, that the Board may request the administrative law judge to direct a licentiate found to have committed a violation of the licensing act to pay a sum not to exceed its reasonable costs of investigation and enforcement.

CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES / DANGEROUS DRUGS

"Controlled substance" means any substance listed in Chapter 2 (commencing

"Dangerous drug" or "dangerous device" means any drug or device unsafe for self use, except veterinary drugs that are labeled as such, and includes the following:

- (a) Any drug that bears the legend: "Caution: federal law prohibits dispensing
- (c) Any other drug or device that by federal or state law can be lawfully

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- Lortab, and Lorcet, is a Schedule II controlled substance pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 11055(b)(I), and dangerous drug as designated by Business and Professions Code section
- Ultram is a brand name for tramadol, an opioid pain medication and a dangerous drug
- On more than 40 occasions between March 2020 and late November 2022, while employed as a staff pharmacist at Rite Aid (#5992) in San Jose, California, Respondent diverted tramadol and hydrocodone/acetaminophen by creating and filling fraudulent prescriptions for her personal use. In total, Respondent diverted approximately 3,000 tablets of tramadol 50mg, and
 - Respondent was terminated from her position in December 2022.

FIRST CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

(Obtaining a Controlled Substance by Fraud, Deceit or Subterfuge)

22. Respondent is subject to discipline under Code sections 4301 (j), 4301 (o) and/or Health and Safety Code section 11173 (a), in that Respondent obtained, conspired to obtain, and/or assisted in or abetted the obtaining of a controlled substance, by fraud, deceit, subterfuge, or concealment of material fact, as described in paragraph 20, above, and herein incorporated.

SECOND CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

(Possession of a Controlled Substance)

23. Respondent is subject to discipline under Code sections 4301 (j), 4301 (o), 4060 and/or Health and Safety Code section 11350, for possession of a controlled substance or substances without a prescription, as described in paragraph 20, above, and herein incorporated.

THIRD CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

(Furnishing a Dangerous Drug/Controlled Substance)

24. Respondent is subject to discipline under Code sections 4301 (j), 4301 (o), 4059 (a), and/or Health and Safety Code section 11170, in that Respondent furnished to herself or another without a valid prescription, and/or conspired to furnish, and/or assisted or abetted furnishing of, a dangerous drug and/or a controlled substance, as described in paragraph 20, above, and herein incorporated.

FOURTH CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

(Acts Involving Moral Turpitude, Dishonesty or Fraud)

25. Respondent is subject to discipline under Code section 4301 (f) for committing an act or acts involving moral turpitude, dishonesty, fraud, deceit, or corruption, as described in paragraph 20, above, and herein incorporated.

OTHER MATTERS

26. Pursuant to Code section 4307, if discipline is imposed on Respondent's Pharmacist License No. RPH 54585, she shall be prohibited from serving as a manager, administrator, owner, member, officer, director, associate, or partner of a licensee for: five years if the license is placed on probation; or if the license is revoked, until it is reinstated or reissued.

PRAYER 1 2 WHEREFORE, Complainant requests that a hearing be held on the matters herein alleged, and that following the hearing, the Board of Pharmacy issue a decision: 3 Revoking or suspending Pharmacist License Number RPH 54585, issued to Oanh 1. 4 5 Nhu Nguyen; 2. Ordering Oanh Nhu Nguyen to pay the Board of Pharmacy the reasonable costs of the 6 7 investigation and enforcement of this case, pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 125.3; and, 8 3.
