- 13. Pursuant to its authority under Government Code section 11520, the Board finds Respondents are in default. The Board will take action without further hearing and, based on the relevant evidence contained in the Default Decision Investigatory Evidence Packet in this matter, finds that the charges and allegations in Accusation No. 7594, are separately and severally, found to be true and correct by clear and convincing evidence.
- 14. The Board finds that the actual costs for Investigation and Enforcement are \$18,642.50 as of March 1, 2024.

## **DETERMINATION OF ISSUES**

- 1. Based on the foregoing findings of fact:
- a. Respondent West Coast HS (US) Pharmacy, LLC, dba Medical Center Pharmacy #2; Mark Catroppa, Chief Financial Officer, President and Manager; Manoj Sikka, Vice-President has subjected its Pharmacy Permit No. PHY 58439 to discipline.
- b. Respondent West Coast HS (US) Pharmacy, LLC, dba Medical Pharmacy #1; Mark Catroppa, Chief Executive Officer, President and Manager; Manoj Sikka, Vice-President, has subjected its Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 58443 to discipline.
- c. Respondent West Coast HS (US) Pharmacy, LLC, dba Medical Center Pharmacy #2; Mark Catroppa, Chief Executive Officer, President and Manager; Manoj Sikka, Vice-President, has subjected its Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 58439 to discipline.
- d. Respondent West Coast HS (US) Pharmacy, LLC, dba Medical Center Pharmacy #9; Mark Catroppa, Chief Executive Officer, President, and Manager; Manoj Sikka, Vice-President, has subjected its Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 58441 to discipline.
- e. Respondent West Coast HS (US) Pharmacy, LLC, dba Medical Center Pharmacy #12; Mark Catroppa, Chief Executive Officer, President and Manager; Manoj Sikka, Vice-President, has subjected its Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 58444 to discipline.
- f. Respondent West Coast HS (US) Pharmacy, LLC, dba Medical Center Pharmacy #13; Mark Catroppa, Chief Executive Officer, President, and Manager; Manoj Sikka, Vice-President, has subjected its Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 58440 to discipline.

Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 58440, issued to West Coast HS (US) Pharmacy, LLC, dba Medical Center Pharmacy #13; Mark Catroppa, Chief Executive Officer, President, and Manager; Manoj Sikka, Vice-President, is revoked.

Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 58442, issued to West Coast HS (US) Pharmacy, LLC, dba Medical Center Pharmacy LTC; Mark Catroppa, Chief Executive Officer, President and Manager; Manoj Sikka, Vice-President, is revoked.

Pursuant to Government Code section 11520, subdivision (c), Respondents may serve a written motion requesting that the Decision be vacated and stating the grounds relied on within seven (7) days after service of the Decision on Respondent. The agency in its discretion may vacate the Decision and grant a hearing on a showing of good cause, as defined in the statute.

Upon revocation per this Order, under Business and Professions Code section 4307, subdivision (a), Respondents shall be prohibited from serving as a manager, administrator, owner, member, officer, director, associate, partner, or serving in any other position with management or control of a licensee. This prohibition shall continue until the license is issued or reinstated.

Upon revocation per this Order, under Business and Professions Code section 4307, subdivision (a), Mark Catroppa and Manoj Sikka shall be prohibited from serving as a manager, administrator, owner, member, officer, director, associate, partner, or serving in any other position with management or control of a licensee. This prohibition shall continue until the license is issued or reinstated.

This Decision shall become effective at 5:00 p.m. on May 8, 2024.

It is so ORDERED on April 8, 2024.

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## 14. Section 4301 of the Code states in pertinent part:

The board shall take action against any holder of a license who is guilty of unprofessional conduct or whose license has been issued by mistake. Unprofessional conduct shall include, but is not limited to, any of the following:

(j) The violation of any of the statutes of this state, of any other state, or of the United States regulating controlled substances and dangerous drugs.

(o) Violating or attempting to violate, directly or indirectly, or assisting in or abetting the violation of or conspiring to violate any provision or term of this chapter or of the applicable federal and state laws and regulations governing pharmacy, including regulations established by the board or any other state or federal regulatory agency.

## 15. Section 4307, subdivision (a) of the Code states that:

Any person who has been denied a license or whose license has been revoked or is under suspension, or who has failed to renew his or her license while it was under suspension, or who has been a manager, administrator, owner member, officer, director, associate, partner, or any other person with management or control of any partnership, corporation, firm, or association whose application for a license has been denied or revoked, is under suspension or has been placed on probation, and while acting as the manger, administrator, owner, member, officer, director, associate, partner, or any other person with management or control had knowledge or knowingly participated in any conduct for which the license was denied, revoked, suspended, or placed on probation, shall be prohibited from serving as a manger, administrator, owner, member, officer, director, associate, partner, or any other person with management or control of a licensee as follows:

- (1) Where a probationary license is issued or where an existing license is placed on probation, this prohibition shall remain in effect for a period not to exceed five years.
- (2) Where the license is denied or revoked, the prohibition shall continue until the license is issued or reinstated.

#### 16. Health and Safety Code section 111255 states:

Any drug or device is adulterated if it has been produced, prepared, packed, or held under conditions whereby it may have been contaminated with filth, or whereby it may have been rendered injurious to health.

## 17. Health and Safety Code section 111295 states:

It is unlawful for any person to manufacture, sell, deliver, hold, or offer for sale any drug or device that is adulterated.

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**COSTS** 

20. Section 125.3 of the Code provides, in pertinent part, that the Board may request the administrative law judge to direct a licentiate found to have committed a violation or violations of the licensing act to pay a sum not to exceed the reasonable costs of the investigation and enforcement of the case.

# **FACTUAL ALLEGATIONS**

- 21. West Coast HS (US) Pharmacy, LLC, owned six pharmacies in Southern California, namely Medical Center Pharmacy #1, Medical Center Pharmacy #2, Medical Center Pharmacy #9, Medical Center Pharmacy #12, Medical Center Pharmacy # 13, and Medical Center Pharmacy LTC (collectively Medical Center Pharmacies).
- 22. On or around December 28, 2022, the Board was notified that Medical Center Pharmacies were abandoned. The Board initiated an investigation which demonstrated that all six Medical Center Pharmacies had closed for business on or around November 9, 2022, but failed to submit a Discontinuance of Business form with the Board, or properly notify the Board of the closures. In addition, Medical Center Pharmacies had abandoned their inventory of dangerous drugs and controlled substances, and their patient records inside the facilities.
- 23. On January 10, 2023, the Board Inspector sent Mark Catroppa as Chief Executive Officer, President and Manager, and Manoj Sikka as Vice-President, instructions regarding the submission of the required Discontinuance of Business forms to the Board. The Board further instructed them to arrange for the disposition of all dangerous drugs and controlled substances that were abandoned at Medical Center Pharmacies within ten days. Neither Mark Catroppa nor Manoj Sikka responded to the Board's instructions.
- 24. The controlled substances that were left inside the abandoned pharmacies were eventually confiscated and destroyed by the Drug Enforcement Administration. The dangerous drugs that were left inside the abandoned pharmacies were deemed adulterated and were eventually sent to a reverse distributor for destruction as facilitated by the Board. Discontinuance of Business forms were received on or about January 16, 2023, with closure dates of "October 2022."

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#### FIRST CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

### (Unprofessional Conduct)

25. Respondents are subject to disciplinary action under Business and Professions Code section 4301 for unprofessional conduct in that Respondents abandoned controlled substances and/or dangerous drugs and/or patient records, and failed to notify the Board of their closure for months, as set forth above in paragraphs 21 through 24.

#### **SECOND CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE**

## (Failure to Maintain Security)

26. Respondents are subject to disciplinary action under Business and Professions Code section 4301, subdivision (o) for violation of California Code of Regulations, title 16, section 1714, in that Respondents failed to maintain their facilities, space, fixtures, and equipment so that drugs are safely and properly maintained and secured, as set forth above in paragraphs 21 through 24.

# OTHER MATTERS

- 27. Pursuant to Code section 4307, if discipline is imposed on Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 58443, issued to West Coast HS (US) Pharmacy, LLC, dba Medical Pharmacy #1, West Coast HS (US) Pharmacy shall be prohibited from serving as a manager, administrator, owner, member, officer, director, associate, or partner of a licensee for five years if Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 58443 is placed on probation or until Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 58443 is reinstated if it is revoked.
- 28. Pursuant to Code section 4307, if discipline is imposed on Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 58439, issued to West Coast HS (US) Pharmacy, LLC, dba Medical Center Pharmacy #2, West Coast HS (US) Pharmacy, LLC shall be prohibited from serving as a manager, administrator, owner, member, officer, director, associate, or partner of a licensee for five years if Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 58439 is placed on probation or until Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 58439 is reinstated if it is revoked.
- 29. Pursuant to Code section 4307, if discipline is imposed on Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 58441, issued to West Coast HS (US) Pharmacy, LLC, dba Medical Center Pharmacy #9,

West Coast HS (US) Pharmacy, LLC, shall be prohibited from serving as a manager, administrator, owner, member, officer, director, associate, or partner of a licensee for five years if Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 58441 is placed on probation or until Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 58441 is reinstated if it is revoked.

- 30. Pursuant to Code section 4307, if discipline is imposed on Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 58444, issued to West Coast HS (US) Pharmacy, LLC, dba Medical Center Pharmacy #12, West Coast HS (US) Pharmacy, LLC, shall be prohibited from serving as a manager, administrator, owner, member, officer, director, associate, or partner of a licensee for five years if Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 58444 is placed on probation or until Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 58444 is reinstated if it is revoked.
- 31. Pursuant to Code section 4307, if discipline is imposed on Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 58442, issued to West Coast HS (US) Pharmacy, LLC, dba Medical Center Pharmacy LTC, West Coast HS (US) Pharmacy, LLC, shall be prohibited from serving as a manager, administrator, owner, member, officer, director, associate, or partner of a licensee for five years if Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 58442 is placed on probation or until Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 58442 is reinstated if it is revoked.
- 32. Pursuant to Code section 4307, if discipline is imposed on Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 58443, PHY 58439, PHY 58441, PHY 58444, PHY 58440, or PHY 58442, issued to West Coast HS (US) Pharmacy, LLC, while Mark Catroppa has been an officer and owner and had knowledge of or knowingly participated in any conduct for which the licensees were disciplined, then Mark Catroppa shall be prohibited from serving as a manager, administrator, owner, member, officer, director, associate, or partner of a licensee for five years if Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 58443, PHY 58439, PHY 58441, PHY 58444, PHY 58440, or PHY 58442, issued to West Coast HS (US) Pharmacy, LLC is placed on probation or until they are reinstated if they are revoked.
- 33. Pursuant to Code section 4307, if discipline is imposed on Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 58443, PHY 58439, PHY 58441, PHY 58444, PHY 58440, or PHY 58442, issued to West Coast HS (US) Pharmacy, LLC, while Manoj Sikka has been an officer and owner and had

knowledge of or knowingly participated in any conduct for which the licensees were disciplined, then Manoj Sikka shall be prohibited from serving as a manager, administrator, owner, member, officer, director, associate, or partner of a licensee for five years if Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 58443, PHY 58439, PHY 58441, PHY 58444, PHY 58440, or PHY 58442, issued to West Coast HS (US) Pharmacy, LLC is placed on probation or until they are reinstated if they are revoked.

#### **PRAYER**

WHEREFORE, Complainant requests that a hearing be held on the matters herein alleged, and that following the hearing, the Board of Pharmacy issue a decision:

- 1. Revoking or suspending Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 58443, issued to West Coast HS (US) Pharmacy, LLC, dba Medical Pharmacy #1; Mark Catroppa, Chief Executive Officer, President and Manager; Manoj Sikka, Vice-President;
- 2. Revoking or suspending Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 58439, issued to West Coast HS (US) Pharmacy, LLC, dba Medical Center Pharmacy #2; Mark Catroppa, Chief Executive Officer, President and Manager; Manoj Sikka, Vice-President;
- 3. Revoking or suspending Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 58441, issued to West Coast HS (US) Pharmacy, LLC, dba Medical Center Pharmacy #9; Mark Catroppa, Chief Executive Officer, President, and Manager; Manoj Sikka, Vice-President;
- 4. Revoking or suspending Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 58444, issued to West Coast HS (US) Pharmacy, LLC, dba Medical Center Pharmacy #12; Mark Catroppa, Chief Executive Officer, President and Manager; Manoj Sikka, Vice-President;
- 5. Revoking or suspending Pharmacy Permit Number PHY 58440, issued to West Coast HS (US) Pharmacy, LLC, dba Medical Center Pharmacy #13; Mark Catroppa, Chief Executive Officer, President, and Manager; Manoj Sikka, Vice-President;
