Cease and Desist Order

Authority for this Action

Business and Professions Code Section 4316, subdivision (a), states, "the board, through its executive officer, is authorized to issue a cease and desist order for operating any facility under this chapter that requires licensure without obtaining that licensure or for practicing any activity under this chapter that requires licensure." Subdivision (b) of that section provides that, whenever the board issues a cease and desist order, the Board must immediately issue the facility a notice setting forth the acts or omissions with which it is charged, specifying the pertinent code section or sections and any regulations.

Activities under this chapter that require licensure include those set forth in the following regulations:

Business and Professions Code section 4037, subdivision (a) "Pharmacy" means an area, place, or premises licensed by the board in which the profession of pharmacist is practiced and where prescriptions are compounded. "Pharmacy" includes, but is not limited to, any area, place, or premises described in a license issued by the board wherein controlled substances, dangerous drugs, or dangerous devices are stored, possessed, prepared, manufactured, derived, compounded, or repackaged, and from which the controlled substances, dangerous drugs, or dangerous devices are furnished, sold, or dispensed at retail.

Business and Professions Code (BPC) section 4112, subdivision (a) states any pharmacy located outside this state that ships, mails, or delivers, in any manner, controlled substances, dangerous drugs, or dangerous devices into this state shall be considered a nonresident pharmacy. As related, BPC 4112, subdivision (b) states a person may not act as a nonresident pharmacy unless he or she has obtained a license from the board. The board may register a nonresident pharmacy that is organized as a limited liability company in the state in which it is licensed.

Business and Professions Code (BPC) section 4127.2, subdivision (a) states a nonresident pharmacy shall not compound sterile drug products for shipment into this state without a sterile compounding pharmacy license issued by the board pursuant to this section. The license shall be renewed annually and shall not be transferable.

Business and Professions Code section 4201, subdivision (a), states, each application to conduct a pharmacy, wholesaler, third-party logistics provider, veterinary food-animal drug retailer, or outsourcing facility shall be made on a form furnished by the board and shall state the name, address, usual occupation, and professional qualifications, if any, of the applicant. If the applicant is other than a natural person, the application shall state the information as to each person beneficially interested therein or any person with management or control over the license. Business and Professions Code section 4201, subdivision (e), states, upon the approval of the application by the board and payment of the fee required by this chapter for each pharmacy, wholesaler, third-party logistics provider, or veterinary food-animal drug retailer, the executive officer of the board shall issue a license to conduct a pharmacy, wholesaler, third-party logistics provider, veterinary food-animal drug retailer, or outsourcing facility if all of the provisions of this chapter have been complied with. Business and Professions Code section 4201, subdivision (f), states, notwithstanding any other law, the pharmacy license shall authorize the holder to conduct a pharmacy. The license shall be renewed annually and shall not be transferable.

Acts or Omissions Upon Which this Action is Based

Greenwich Rx, located at 9733 RM 2020 Road, Suite 100, Tomball, TX 77375, is not licensed as a nonresident pharmacy nor as a nonresident sterile compounding pharmacy by the California State Board of Pharmacy.

On or about March 9, 2026, during an investigation it was discovered Greenwich Rx sold dangerous drugs into California without a license. Records received on March 9, 2026 from Greenwich Rx, showed at least 253,523 prescriptions were sold and shipped into California from May 8, 2025 through March 2, 2026. Prescriptions for compounded preparations were received through a telehealth platform, namely www.joiamble.com, who utilized Greenwich Rx, that was unlicensed in California, to fill prescriptions for patients in California.

The total unlicensed activity discovered was:

24,839	Non-sterile dermal or oral preparations
228,684	Sterile compounded preparations
253,523	Total prescriptions shipped to California

Greenwich Rx was required to obtain a license pursuant to BPC 4112, subdivision (b) and BPC 4127.1, subdivision (a) before shipping, mailing, and/or delivering any prescription drug and prescription compounded preparation into California as a nonresident pharmacy and as a nonresident sterile compounding pharmacy.

Order

On the basis of the foregoing, the Board, through its Executive Officer therefore ORDERS:

Effective immediately, Greenwich Rx, located at 9733 RM 2020 Road, Suite 100, Tomball, TX 77375, an unlicensed nonresident pharmacy and unlicensed nonresident sterile compounding pharmacy in California, shall cease and desist practicing any activity under this chapter that requires licensure, including shipping, mailing and delivering any dangerous drugs, dangerous devices and prescription compounded preparations into California.

Unlicensed Entity's Right to be Heard and Procedure

Pursuant to Business and Professions Code Section 4316, subdivision (c), within 15 days of receipt of this notice, Greenwich Rx, may request a hearing before the president of the Board to contest this cease-and-desist order. Any contest of the cease-and-desist order will comply with the requirements of Section 11425.10 of the Government Code, a copy of which is enclosed. Chapter 5 of the Administrative Procedure Act (commencing at Government Code Section 11500) does not apply to this proceeding. The hearing will be held no later than five (5) days from the date the owner's request for a hearing is received by the Board. The president will render a written decision within five (5) days of the hearing. In the absence of the president of the Board, the vice president of the Board may conduct the hearing permitted by this subdivision. Review of the decision of the president of the Board may be sought by the owner or person in possession or control of the unlicensed entity pursuant to Section 1094.5 of the Code of Civil Procedure.


