This rulemaking action by the Board of Pharmacy (Board) repeals and adopts regulations specific to the compounding of nonsterile, sterile, hazardous, and radiopharmaceutical drug products to improve the regulation and enforcement of facilities, pharmacist, and personnel licensed by the Board who are engaged in the activity by aligning the regulations with standards set forth in the current version of the United States Pharmacopeia-National Formulary (USP), including relevant testing and

quality assurances, and imposing additional standards above the minimum national standards set by USP.

OAL approves this regulatory action pursuant to section 11349.3 of the Government Code. This regulatory action becomes effective on 10/1/2025.
