## EMSA Authorization of Out-Of-State Medical Personnel

Important Reminder: Following the anticipated termination of California's COVID-19 State of Emergency on February 28, 2023, health care providers licensed out-of-state who received the Emergency Medical Services Authority's (EMSA) authorization to practice in the state without a license issued by the California State Board of Pharmacy will no longer be permitted to practice pursuant to that authorization after that date. Please note, individuals wishing to continue to practice in California should submit an application and the necessary documentation for licensure immediately as the EMSA out-of-state medical personnel authorization approval concludes on February 28, 2023, and no further practice pursuant to that authorization will be permitted.
