## Board Meeting Actions – July 29-30, 2020

The California State Board of Pharmacy took the following actions during a teleconference meeting July 29-30, 2020:

- Adopted regulatory language as noticed to amend Title 16, CCR sections 1780-1783 et seq., Related to Dangerous Drug Distributors and Third-Party Logistics Providers.
- Voted to pursue a proposal to amend BPC 4052.8 related to pharmacist authority to administer vaccines approved by the FDA.
- Approved amendments to initial proposed text for Title 16, CCR section 1746.6,
  Independent HIV Preexposure and Postexposure Prophylaxis Furnishing.
- Voted to initiate rulemaking to add Title 16, CCR section 1708.1, Notification of Temporary Closure.
- Voted to initiate rulemaking to amend Title 16, CCR section 1704, Providing Addresses.
- Delegated authority to the Board president to grant a Pharmacy Law waiver for up to 90 days plus two 90-day extensions.

The Board also voted positions on the following legislation:

- AB 2028: Oppose unless amended.
- <u>AB 2077</u>: Support.
- AB 2549: Oppose unless amended.
- AB 3045: Oppose unless amended.
