LICENSING COMMITTEE REPORT

a. Update on Implementation of Recently Enacted Legislation Impacting the Practice of Pharmacy SB 159 (Weiner, Chapter 532, Statutes of 2019) Related to HIV Preexposure and Postexposure Prophylaxis

Background

As part of the November 2019 Board Meeting, the board discussed the provisions of SB 159 including the statutory provisions requiring the board to adopt emergency regulations by July 1, 2020. The board referred development of these regulations to the Licensing Committee.

As provided in the legislation, prior to a pharmacist furnishing preexposure or postexposure prophylaxis, a pharmacist shall complete a training program approved by the board, in consultation with the Medical Board of California, on the use of the preexposure or postexposure prophylaxis. Further, the statute specifies specific areas that must be covered in the training program including information about financial assistance programs.

Subsequent to Committee discussions, as part of its January 2020 meeting, the Board considered and voted to adopt, as emergency regulations, a proposal to add Section 1747 to Title 16 of the California Code of Regulations.

Following completion of the pre-review process, the emergency regulation was published on April 20, 2020 for the required five-day comment period. Comments were submitted by the Food and Drug Administration. Consistent with the provisions of the Administrative Procedures Act, the Office of Administrative Law will make a decision on the emergency regulation by May 1. Updated information will be provided under Agenda Item under VIII(b)(3) during the meeting.

In addition to the regulation itself, board staff, in concert with subject matter experts and representatives from the Office of AIDS, are working on development of a training program that could be delivered via webinar. Board staff is hopeful that the framework of the training program will be complete for the board's consideration during its June Board Meeting.

b. Review of Licensing Statistics

Licensing statistics for July 1, 2019 through March 31, 2020, are provided in Attachment 1.

As of March 31, 2020, the board has received 10, 914 initial applications, including:

- 1,816 intern pharmacists
- 690 pharmacist exam applications
- 166 advanced practice pharmacists
- 3,674 pharmacy technicians
- 300 community pharmacy license applications
- 97 sterile compounding pharmacy license applications
- 98 nonresident pharmacy license applications
- 21 hospital pharmacy license applications
- 279 automated drug delivery system applications

As of March 31, 2020, the board has received 388 requests for <u>temporary</u> site license applications, including:

- 203 community pharmacy license applications
- 39 sterile compounding pharmacy license applications
- 64 nonresident pharmacy license applications
- 18 hospital pharmacy license applications

As of March 31, 2020, the board has issued 9,322 licenses, renewed 49,927 licenses and has 141,573 active licenses, including:

- 6,959 intern pharmacists
- 47,876 pharmacists
- 670 advanced practice pharmacists
- 69,534 pharmacy technicians
- 6,534 community pharmacies
- 501 hospital pharmacies
- 901 automated drug delivery systems

Processing Times

The general application and deficiency mail processing times by license type are provided below reflecting data current as of April 24, 2020. The data reflects the time from when an application or deficiency response is received by the board through to the time it is processed by licensing staff.

The standard performance processing time is within 30 days for initial applications and is within 10 days for deficiency mail.
