## Board Meeting Actions – September 23, 2021

The California State Board of Pharmacy met and took the following actions September 23, 2021:

- Reviewed comments and voted to adopt regulation language for Title 16, California Code of Regulations, section 1709, related to Ownership, Management & Control of Business Entities.
- Delegated authority to the Board president to approve or extend pharmacy law waivers as appropriate based on current conditions through June 31, 2022, or until 90 days following the declared disaster, whichever is sooner.
- Delegated authority to the Board president to extend the <u>pharmacy law waiver for mass</u> <u>vaccination sites</u> at the president's discretion after consultation with the California Department of Public Health.
- Delegated authority to the Board president to extend a waiver to allow for a license for a California Department of Public Health (CDPH) alternate care site facility in Sacramento through the end of the year and at the president's discretion after consultation with CDPH.
- Granted recognition to the University of California, Irvine, School of Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Sciences for purposes of issuing intern licenses.
- Discussed the results of an environmental scan and approved goals and objectives for a new Strategic Plan.
