

Board Meeting Highlights – June 24-25, 2026

The California State Board of Pharmacy took the following actions at its meeting on June 24-25, 2026:

- Authorized that Member Nicole Thibeau's attendance and participation from a remote location shall count toward the establishment of a quorum, as permitted by California Government Code section 11123.2(j).
- Approved minutes of the April 29-30, 2026 Board meeting and the May 19, 2026 Disciplinary Petition Committee meeting.
- Rescinded the October 26, 2022 motion to initiate a rulemaking to add sections 1750 and 1750.1 (related to outsourcing facilities) to title 16 of the California Code of Regulations (CCR).
- Approved the following self-assessment forms consistent with the Board's discussion, and delegated to the chair of the Enforcement and Compounding Committee to work with staff to incorporate suggested changes and any other nonsubstantive changes into the forms:
 - Automated Drug Delivery System Self-Assessment
 - Compounding Self-Assessment
 - Outsourcing Facility Self-Assessment
- Initiated a rulemaking to amend CCR, title 16, section 1707 (related to waiver requirements for off-site storage of records) as proposed.
- Initiated a rulemaking to amend CCR, title 16, section 1708.2 (related to discontinuance of business) as proposed.
- Approved Frequently Asked Questions related to continuing education (CE) requirements for pharmacists.
- Initiated a rulemaking to add section 1713.1 (related to automated patient dispensing system location) to title 16 of the CCR as proposed.
- Approved awarding two hours of CE credit to pharmacists who complete the Board's job analysis survey for the California Practice Standards and Jurisprudence Examination for Pharmacists (CPJE).
