Title 16. Board of Pharmacy

Proposed Regulation Text

Add Section 1713.1 to Article 2 of Division 17 of Title 16 of the California Code of Regulations to read as follows:

§1713.1 Automated Patient Dispensing System Location

- (a) For purposes of subdivision (j) of Section 4427.6 of the Business and Professions Code, "a medical office or other location where patients are regularly seen for purposes of diagnosis and treatment" means a building regularly used by licensed physicians and surgeons, doctors of osteopathic medicine or nurse practitioners for the purpose of providing in-person medical diagnosis and treatment of patients, which shall be referred to as an Authorized APDS Location.
- (b) For purposes of subdivision (j) of Section 4427.6 of the Business and Professions Code, "patients of the practice" means individuals who receive medical diagnosis and treatment from health care providers who are part of a practice that maintains an office in an Authorized APDS Location as defined in subsection (a).
