

Board Meeting Highlights – September 17, 2026

The California State Board of Pharmacy took the following actions at its meeting on September 17, 2026:

- Regarding the proposed amendment of California Code of Regulations (CCR), title 16, section 1707.4 related to central fill pharmacies: Accepted the Board staff's recommended second modified text, and directed staff to notice the second modified text for a 15-day comment period and notice the additional document relied upon. Additionally, if no adverse comments are received relating to the second modified text amendment as noticed during the 15-day comment period and the document added to the rulemaking file, authorized the executive officer to take all steps necessary to complete the rulemaking and adopt the proposed regulations at title 16, CCR section 1707.4 as noticed. Further, delegated to the executive officer the authority to make technical or nonsubstantive changes as may be required by the Control agencies to complete the rulemaking file.
- Regarding the proposed amendment of CCR, title 16, section 1749 related to fees: Accepted the Board staff's recommended comment responses and recommended modified text, and directed staff to notice the modified text for a 15-day comment period. Additionally, if no adverse comments are received relating to the modified text amendment as noticed during the 15-day comment period, authorized the executive officer to take all steps necessary to complete the rulemaking and adopt the proposed regulations at title 16, CCR section 1749 as noticed. Further, delegated to the executive officer the authority to make technical or nonsubstantive changes as may be required by the Control agencies to complete the rulemaking file.
